## Crowd watches record pull of more than 400 feet

A good crowd watched and was Richard Bauman of Goodland cheered for the trucks and tractors as the engines roared and the vehicles worked to pull a special sled down the straightaway against an increasing weight and saw a record pull of more than 400 feet.

The scene was Friday night in front of the grandstand at the Sherman County fairgrounds for the Colorado Tractor Pullers Association tractor pull featuring 31 different drivers and modified tractors and trucks. A pull of 300 feet is considered a full pull, and many of the competitors beat that distance.

Danny Davis, Sherman County president, said Tim Pfahl of Lincoln, Neb., beat the pull distance from Benkelman, Neb., with a Blown Mini Rod pull of 402.08 feet in Fake Bake.

Goodland winners for the night were Candi Meissinger in her big block called Plum Nasty with a pull of 297.09 feet, and Davis in his two wheel drive Lack of Common Cents with a pull of 316.67 feet.
