

Wyoming Cowgirls win match

Goodland native Dani Bedore had nine kills Saturday to help the University of Wyoming volleyball team earn its first Mountain West Conference win of the season defeating Brigham Young University in Provo, Utah, 3-1.

The last time the Cowgirls defeated Brigham Young on its home court was in September 1984.

Wyoming won the first set 25-22 but the Cougars came back to win the second 25-19. The Cowgirls responded by winning the third set 25-18 then won the fourth 26-24.

Wyoming is now 15-2 overall and 1-1 in conference play. The Cowgirls lost their conference opener to the University of Utah 3-1 last Thursday in Salt Lake City. Bedore had 10 kills against the Utes.

The next action for Bedore and her teammates will be on their home court Saturday when the Aztecs of San Diego State University visit Laramie. The Aztecs are 7-7 overall and 2-0 in conference play heading into their match at Colorado State University Thursday.

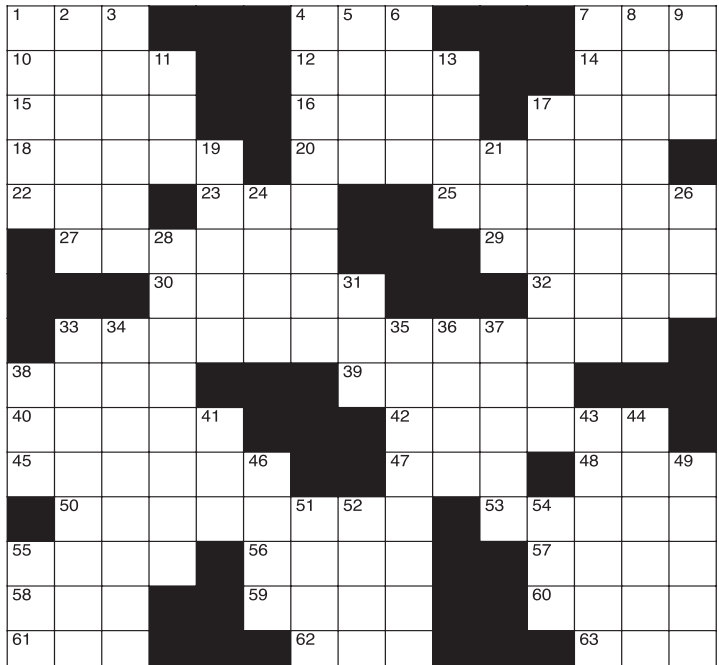
