

Cowgirls win 3A Sub State Championship, play in state tournament on Friday in Salina

The Cowgirls volleyball team knocked off the top seed in the Class 3A Sub State in Lakin on Saturday, and begin pool play in the 3A State Championship Friday at the Bicentennial Center in Salina.

To win the sub state championship the Cowgirls had to shake off a first game loss to Kismet-Southwestern Heights, 25-21 and won the second 25-19. The third and final game was another close one 25-22 to give Goodland the championship and advance to the Class 3A State Championship tournament Friday in Salina.

The Cowgirls (28-11) are seeded eighth in the state tournament and will be in the top bracket for pool play including the top seeded Phillipsburg (38-1), number four Eureka (33-6) and fifth Garden Plain (33-7).

The first pool match at 2:30 p.m. Friday has Goodland facing Garden Plain. The second pool match at 3:30 p.m. is against Phillipsburg and the third match at 6:30 p.m. against Eureka.

Teams in the bottom bracket include the second seeded Osage City (38-2), seventh seed Cherokee-Southeast (29-11), third seed Effingham-Atchison County Community (38-3) and sixth seed Hillsboro (30-10).

If the Cowgirls do well in pool play they will move into the semi-finals at 1 p.m. on Saturday with the consolation and championship matches following 15 minutes after the last semi-final match has concluded.

On Saturday at sub state the Cowgirls defeated Lakin in two games (25-12 and 25-20) in the first round.

In the semi-finals Goodland defeated Hoisington 2 games to 1, winning the first 26-24, lost the second 18-25, and won the third 25-21 to move to the championship. Hoisington the second seed defeated Larned 25-18 and 25-20 in the first round.

Top seeded Kismet-Southwestern Heights defeated Thomas More Prep-Marian 25-18 and 25-6 in the firsts round. Scott City defeated Holcomb 25-17 and 25-22 to advance to the semi-finals.

In the semi-finals Kismet defeated Scott City 2 to 1, losing the first game 23-25, but coming back to win 25-16 and 25-14 to advance.

In the championship match Goodland defeated Kismet 2 to 1 losing the first game 21-25, but winning the second 25-19 and the third 25-22 to win the championship.

A special send off will be held at 3:30 p.m. on Thursday in front of Max Jones Fieldhouse.

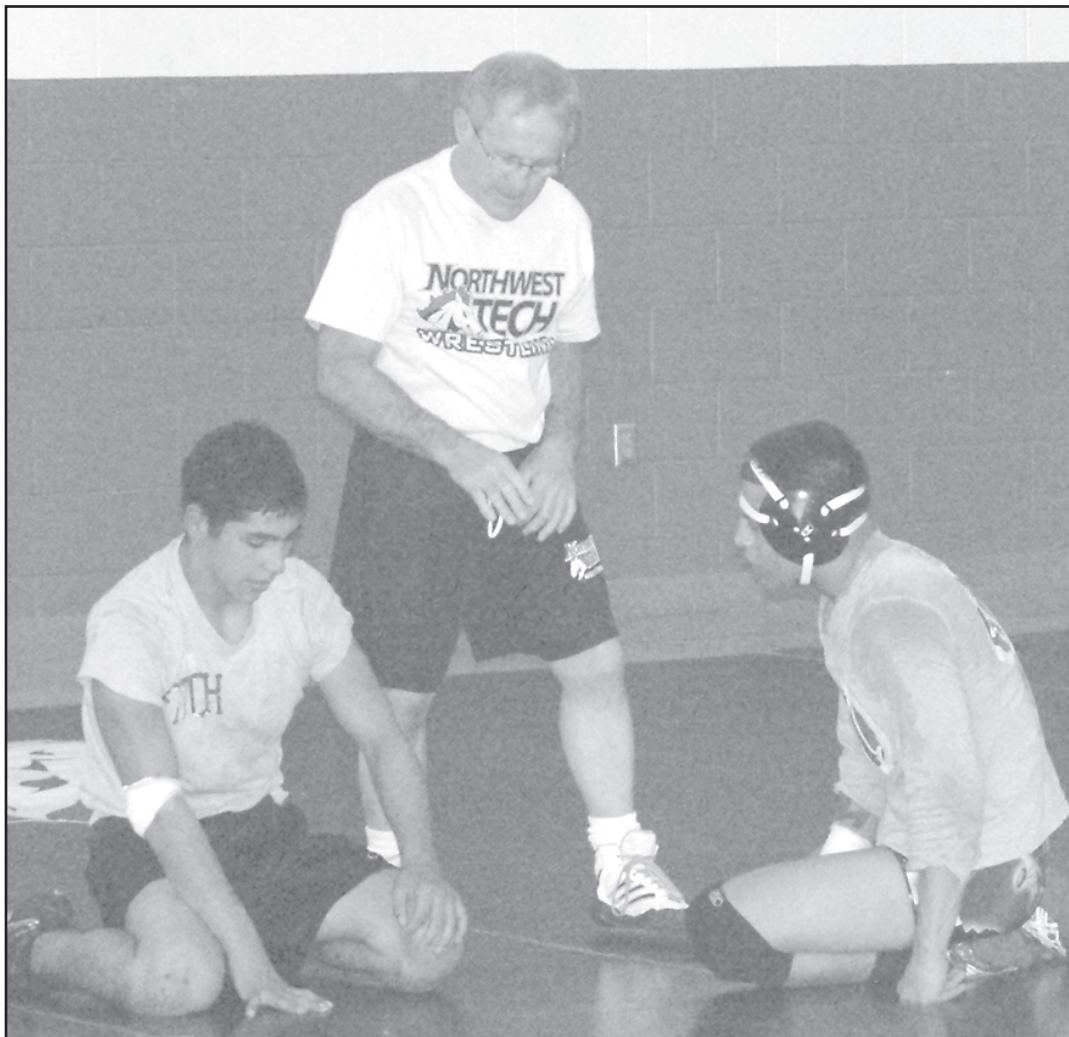
