

# Maverick golfers play in Hutchison at Warrior tourney

Northwest Tech Maverick women golfers participated in the Warrior Invitational golf tournament on Monday and Tuesday last week at Highlands Golf Club in Hutchison.

Coach Travis Jones said Maverick Jennice Hartman was a big surprise shooting 131 and 114 for a two-day total of 245 and finishing 19th in the field of 28. She was low average for the Mavericks with 125 for 18 holes.

Maverick Kalee Konecne had a 121 the first day, but had to withdraw the second day because of a shoulder injury. "She's a fighter," Coach Jones said, "she played 12 holes with one arm, and even then I had to force her out."

Maverick Sara Dexter shot 156 and 165 for a total of 321.

Southwestern College won the tournament with a team score of 377 and 363 for a two-day total of 740. Kansas Wesleyan was second with a two-day total of 835.

Former Goodland Cowgirl golfer Heidi Yonkey was on the Kansas Wesleyan team and finished tied for 12th with a score of 111 and 100 for a two-day total of 211.

The Maverick golf tournament at Sugar Hills Golf Course was scheduled for Sunday and Monday.

Coach Jones said the golf team will be back at Hutchison in the next two weeks for the regional qualifying tournament.

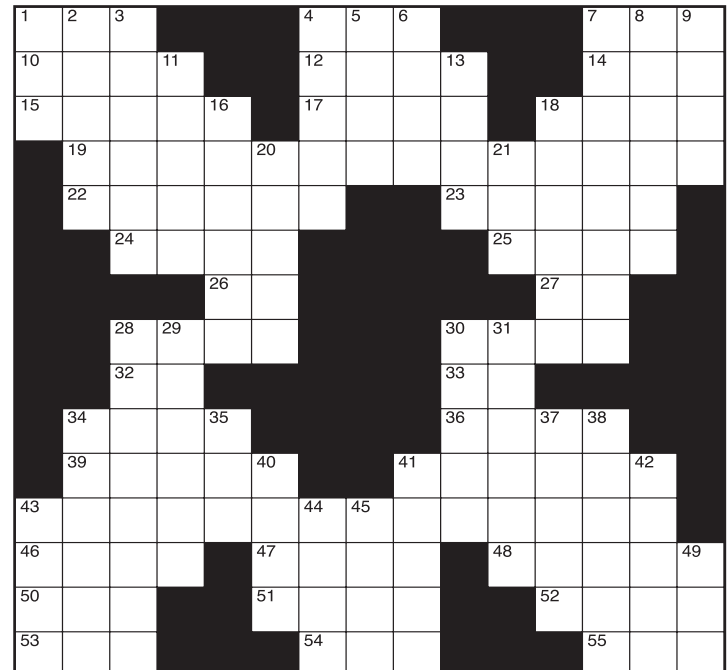


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## Crossword Puzzle
