An individual or charitable/ nonprofit organization may apply for the issuance of a special event retailers f permit which shall allow the permit holder to offer for sale, sell and serve cereal malt beverage for consumption on unpermitted premises, which may be open to the public, subject to the following:

(1) A special event retailers f permit shall specify the premises for which the permit is is-

(2) A special event retailers f permit shall be issued for the duration of the special event, the dates and hours of which shall be specified in the permit;

(3) No more than four special event retailers f permits may be issued to any one applicant in a calendar year; and

(4) A special event retailers f permit shall not be transferable to assignable.

A temporary event permit fee of \$25.00 shall accompany each permit application along with any other state of Kansas fees as required.
