AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE PAYMENT OF FEES FOR COLLECTION OF WASTE MATERIAL AND AMENDING SECTION 117 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. All waste collection bills due the City and/or its contractor shall be payable monthly and all such bills shall be paid on or before the fifteenth (15th) day of each month. Unless payment is made as herein called for, service may be discontinued until such delinquent customer shall have paid all of the arrearage to the City and/or its contractor. In the event there is no electric or water utility service to the property, the waste container will be removed from the premises and the service shall be discontinued until such delinquent customer shall have paid all arrearages to the City and/or its contractor.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect after its publication in the official City fs newspaper.

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES," EDITION OF 2011; PROVIDING CERTAIN PENALTIES AND AMENDING AND REPEALING SECTION NO. 16-101.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. INCORPORATING THE STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Goodland, Kansas, that certain Standard Traffic Ordinance known as the **gStandard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities, h Edition of 2011**, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than three copies of said Standard Traffic Ordinance shall be marked or stamped gOfficial Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 1623, h and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The Police Department, Municipal Judge

and all Administrative Departments of the City charged with enforcement of the ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the City, such number of official copies of such Standard Traffic Ordinance similarly marked, as may be deemed expedient.

SECTION 2. REPEAL. Section No. 16-101 is hereby amended and repealed.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official City Newspaper.

No fewer than three copies of said Uniform Offense Code shall be marked or stamped gOfficial Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 1624, h and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the City Clerk to be opened to inspection

and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The Police Department, Municipal Judge and all Administrative Departments of the City charged with enforcement of the ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the City, such number of official copies of such Uniform Public Offense Code similarly marked, as may be deemed expedient.

SECTION 2. REPEAL. Section No. 12-101 is hereby amended and repealed.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official City Newspaper.

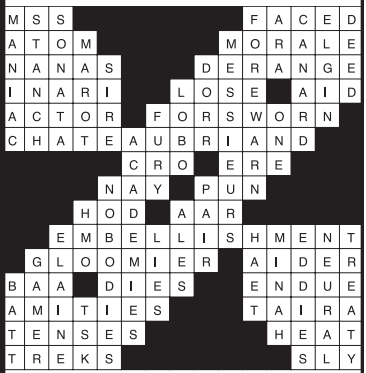
