Northwest Tech Mavericks finish 16th at Hastings, Neb.

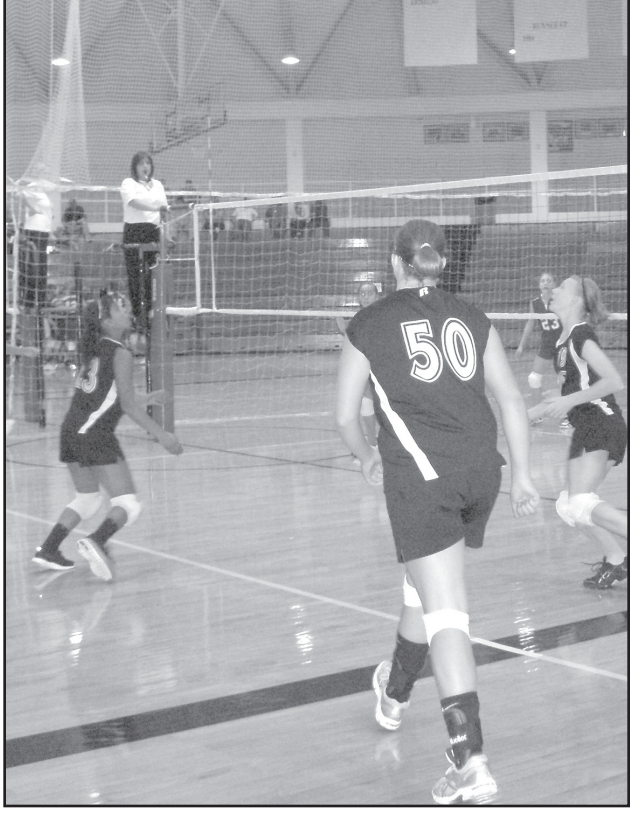
