Plenty of action for crowds at Flatlander Classic

Races on Friday and Saturday had plenty of action and brought out good crowds both nights to see the cars and drivers tame the Sherman County Speedway.

Friday night a total of 117 cars took to the track with races in IMCA Modifieds (53), IMCA Stock cars (30), IMCA Sport Modifieds (17) and IMCA Hobby Stock (17) running.

Saturday night a total of 132 cars were on the track with IMCA Modifieds (52), IMCA Stock cars (32), IMCA Sport Modifieds (16), IMCA Hobby Stock (16) and Econos (16).

Before the races on Saturday the track champions were introduced and received their trophy. Season winner in the Modifieds was Adam Morris (car 8) from Lamar, who said he had a good run and wanted to thank DeLoach Culligan for helping him.

In the Hobby Stock cars Angel Munoz (2M) of Lamar was the season winner, and he posed with his family and trophy. Each driver was given a chance to thank his sponsors. Munoz received a second trophy as the Stock Feature winner from Friday night.

Chris Heim (1) was the track winner in the Sport Modifieds, and received a second trophy as the feature race winner from Friday. Heim was a double winner taking the feature race on Saturday.

Jeff Tubbs (37x) from Colby was the track winner in the Stock car division.

Joe Harper (37) was the season track winner in the Econo division, and won the feature race on Saturday night.

Other feature race winners on Friday were Jeremy Frenier (17J) in Modifieds, Nick Tubbs (737) from Colby in Stocks.

Feature race winners on Saturday included Darren DeLoach (21) of Lamar in Modifieds. He finished second in the preliminary behind Brady Coen (3) of Wiley.

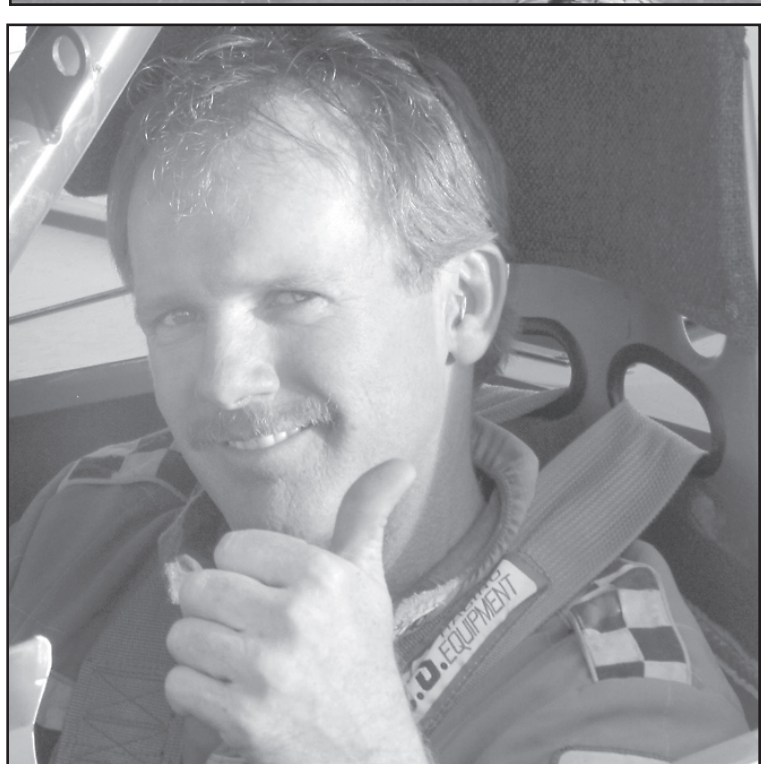
The modifieds preliminary races on Saturday got off to a rough start with spinouts in turn one on the first two race starts. The rest of the preliminary races had similar problems in turn one, and in the start of the next race Coen got through turn one without a problem, but DeLoach ended up in a several car pile up. None of the cars were knocked out, but DeLoach's car did suffer a dented drivers side rear panel.

Wheat Lippelman (444) beat track champion Jeff Tubbs (37x) in the Stock division on Saturday night.

Jimmy Jenkins (97J) was the winner Saturday in the Hobby Stock feature race.

The two nights of racing concludes the season at Sherman County Speedway, and things will be quite until the drivers get the itch to get back out on the track about April when the racing association usually starts with a tune up race.
