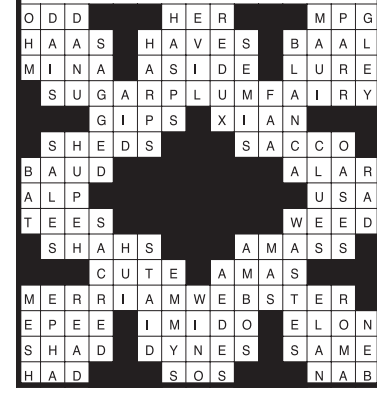

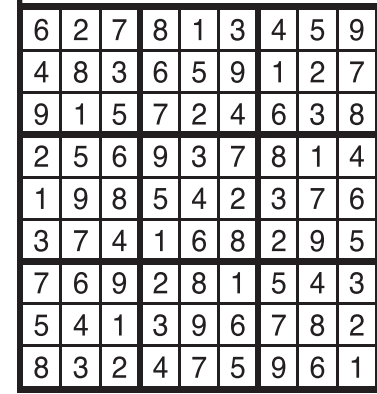

### CITY OF GOODLAND RESOLUTION NO. 1351

WHEREAS, the City of Goodland, Kansas, has received two separate Petitions requesting annexation of real estate to the City of Goodland; and

WHEREAS, said land is platted and adjoins the City;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS, on this 7th day of November, 2011, that the City of Goodland is considering the annexation of real estate pursuant to two Petitions for Annexation filed with the City of Goodland, Kansas:

1. Petitions have been filed by Crop Production Services, Inc. requesting the annexation of two separate lots to the City of Goodland and by Sunrich LLC for the annexation of one lot which lies contiguous to the lots owned by Crop Production Services, Inc.

2. A public hearing to consider the annexation of the land shall be held in the Goodland City Office Building, Commissioners' Room, 2nd floor, on the 16th day of January, 2012, at 5:00 o'clock P.M.

3. The boundaries of the land proposed to be annexed are as follows:

#### Crop Production Services:

A tract of land in the Southeast Quarter (SE/4) of Section

Twenty-four (24), Township Eight (8) South, Range Forty (40), West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, more particularly described as beginning at a point fifty feet (50 f) West of where the North right-of-way line of the Rock Island Railroad crosses the West right-of-way line of Kansas Highway No. 27; thence North parallel to the West right-of-way line of Kansas Highway No. 27; thence North parallel to the West right-of-way line of Kansas Highway No. 27 a distance of 265 feet to the Point of Beginning;

Thence West 230.4 feet; thence North 530.74 feet; thence East a distance of 300 feet to a point 50 feet West of the West right-of-way line of Kansas Highway No. 27; thence in a south-southwesterly direction and parallel to said right-of-way line a distance of 539 feet to the Point of Beginning, said tract containing 3.03 acres, more or less.

A tract of land in the Southeast Quarter (SE/4) of Section Twenty-four (24), Township Eight (8) South, Range Forty (40), West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, more particularly described as beginning at a point

fifty feet (50 f) West of where the North right-of-way line of the Rock Island Railroad crosses the West right-of-way line of Kansas Highway No. 27; thence West along the North right-of-way line of Rock Island Railroad 223.14 feet, thence N 0° 16' W a distance of 265.37 feet, thence East at right angles a distance of 230.4 feet to a point on the West right-of-way line of Kansas Highway No. 27, thence due South a distance of 265 feet to the point of beginning, subject to easements, restrictions, and reservation rights-of-way of record, said tract containing 1.61 acres, more or less.

5. A sketch clearly delineating the area of the particular land proposed to be annexed shall be published with this Resolution. A copy of the sketch will also be mailed to the owners of the property with the Resolution sent to them by certified mail.

6. This Resolution will be sent by certified mail within ten days following the date of its adoption to the following:

(a) Sherman County Board of County Commissioners;

(b) The governing body of the township where the land to be annexed is located;

(c) Utilities having facilities within the area proposed to be annexed;

(d) The governing body of USD #352, Goodland, Kansas.
