

# Northwest Tech to add basketball beginning next fall

At the regular November meeting, Northwest Tech's Area Board of Control voted to begin men and women's basketball for the 2012-2013 school year.

At last week's Goodland School Board meeting, the board voted and agreed to join Northwest Tech in this new collaboration to bring collegiate level basketball to Goodland.

This will allow Northwest Tech Mavericks to use the Max Jones Field House facility for hosting games. Plans are for the college home games to be held on Wednesday and Saturdays.

The Mavericks plan to have approximately nine home games, which will add to student life, and excitement in the community.

"These are, indeed, very exciting times for students and the college," said Dr. Mills, Northwest Tech president.

Northwest Tech has eagerly begun its recruitment for basketball players to sign for next fall.

The basketball program makes the fifth collegiate sport for Northwest Tech. The other sports are golf, rodeo, soccer and wrestling.

## Cowboys open basketball practice



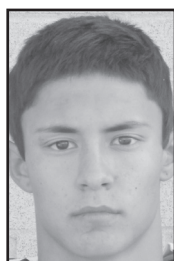

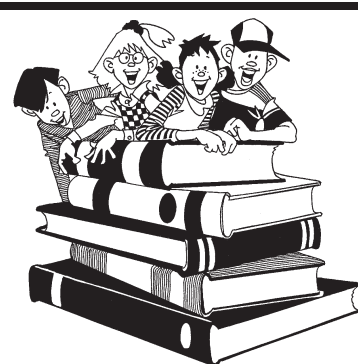

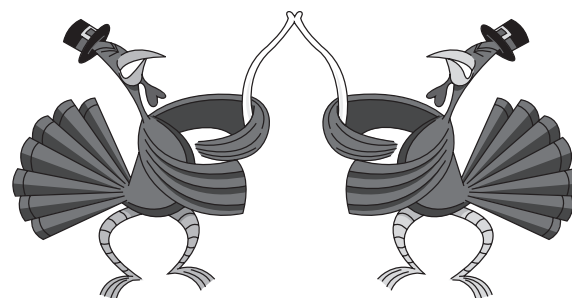
