**From the staff:** We have nominated this student because Zabie has had a great attitude and enthusiasm all year in geometry class.

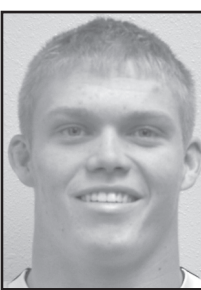
**From the student (favorite aspect of school, favorite subject, what you will remember most, etc.):** going to marketing class, lunch.

**From the student (favorite aspect of school, favorite subject, what you will remember most, etc.):** I will always remember the great GHS Musical productions.

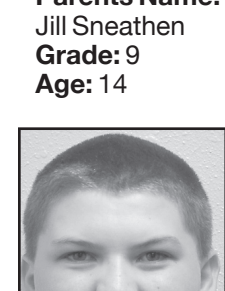

**From the student (favorite aspect of school, favorite subject, what you will remember most, etc.):** Lunch, breakfast, and being Cowboy of the Week.

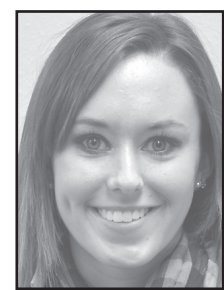
