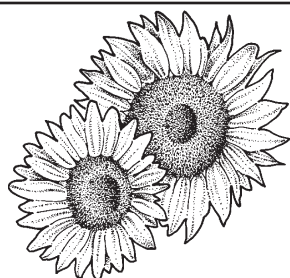

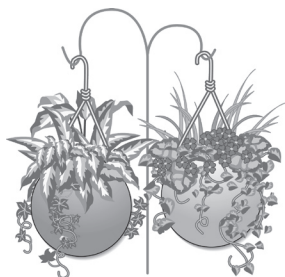

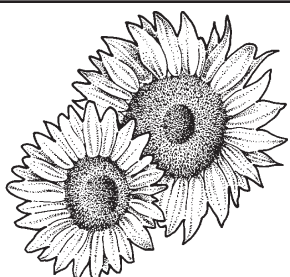

## Hoop Shoot winners go on to district, state level competition

The Goodland Elks Lodge held its annual Hoop Shoot Contest Sunday afternoon, Jan. 8, at the Max Jones Fieldhouse.

A total of 34 girls and boys from Goodland, Brewster, Colby and Burlington participated in the contest. Each participant shoot 25 free throws in the contest. The one sinking the most wins.

First place winners go on to participate at noon on Saturday, Jan. 21, in the Kansas District Contest at Russell. They also received a medal and a basketball. The second place winners received a medal.

In boys aged 8 to 9 in first place was Jared Rush of Levant who goes to the Sacred Heart School at Colby with 20 baskets. In second place was Jacob DeLaRosa of Goodland who goes to Central Elementary School with 19 baskets.

In girls 8 to 9 first place went to Alyssa

Swindle of Burlington who goes to Burlington Elementary School with 14 baskets. Second place went to Trinity Perry of Burlington who goes to Burlington Elementary School with 12 baskets.

In boys aged 10 to 11 first place went to Brandt Mull of Goodland who goes to Grant Junior High School at Goodland with 14 baskets. Second place went to Garin Ihrig of Goodland who goes to Central Elementary School at Goodland with 11 baskets.

In girls 10 to 11 first place went to Jill Stephens of Colby who goes to Sacred Heart School at Colby with 13. She tied with second place winner Megan Burghart of Burlington who goes to Burlington Elementary. In the tiebreaker Stephens made four of five baskets and Burghart three of the five.

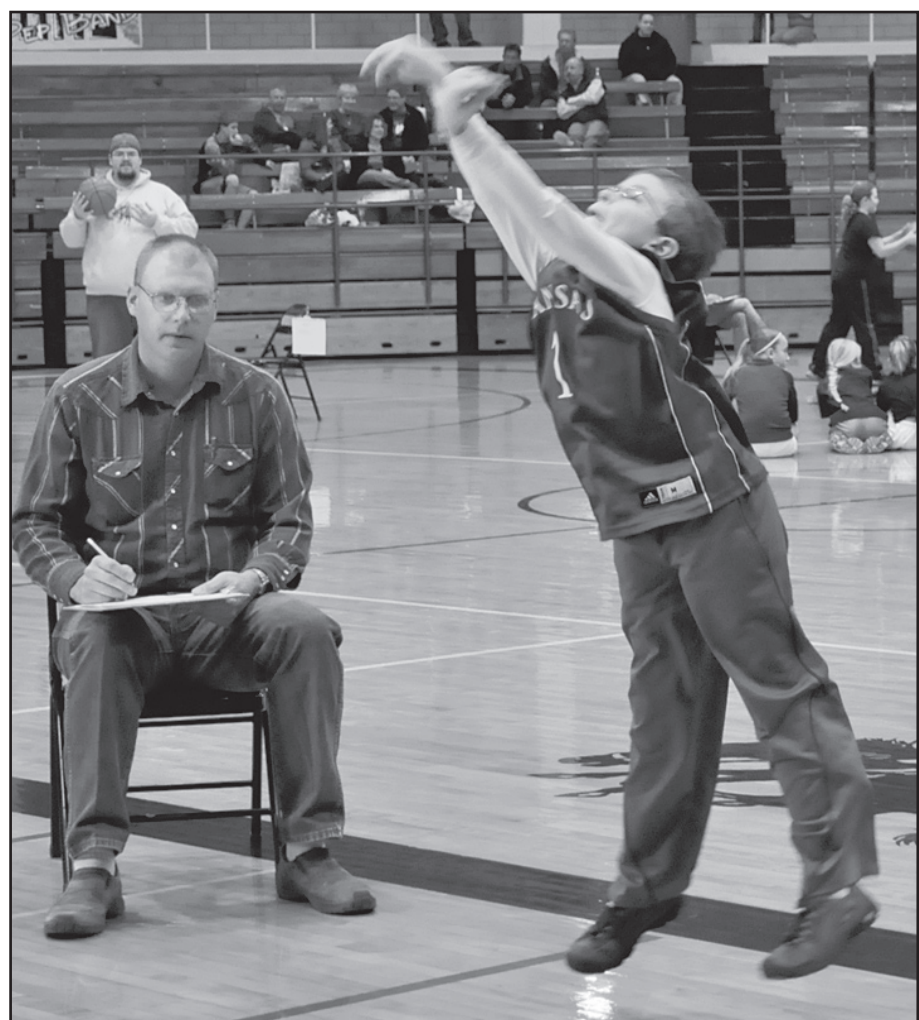
In boys 12 to 13 first place went to Cade Mayer of Brewster who goes to Grant Junior

High with 20 baskets. Second place went to Jett County of Burlington who goes to Burlington Middle School with 16 baskets.

In girls 12 to 13 Margaux Thompson of Goodland who goes to Grant Junior High was first with 19. In second was Natalie Miltenberger of Stratton who goes to Burlington Middle School with 17 baskets.

Two Goodland winners, Swindle (girls aged 8 to 9) and Mayer (boys aged 12 to 13) were first at the District Hoop Shoot at Russell and will go onto the State Hoop Shoot to be held on Saturday, Feb. 11.

The results of the other Goodland Lodge competitors were Russ (boys aged 8 to 9) third, Mull (boys aged 10 to 11) third, Stephens (girls aged 10 to 11) second and Thompson (girls aged 12 to 13).

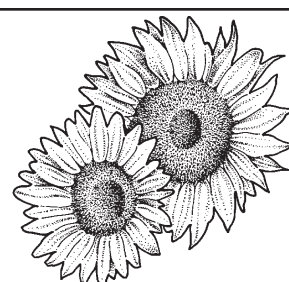

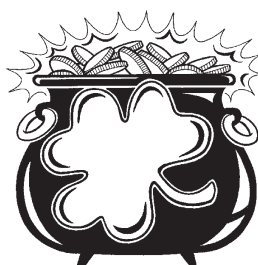
