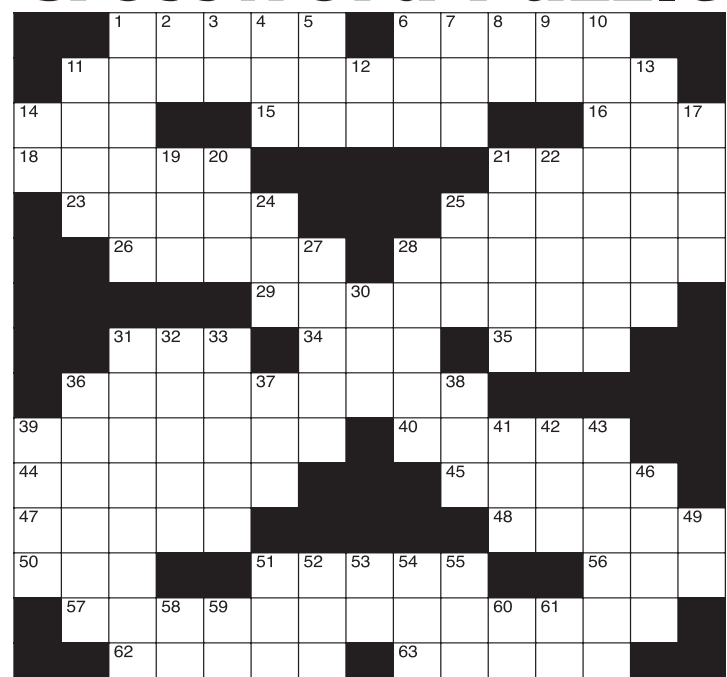
Level: Beginner

Crossword Puzzle

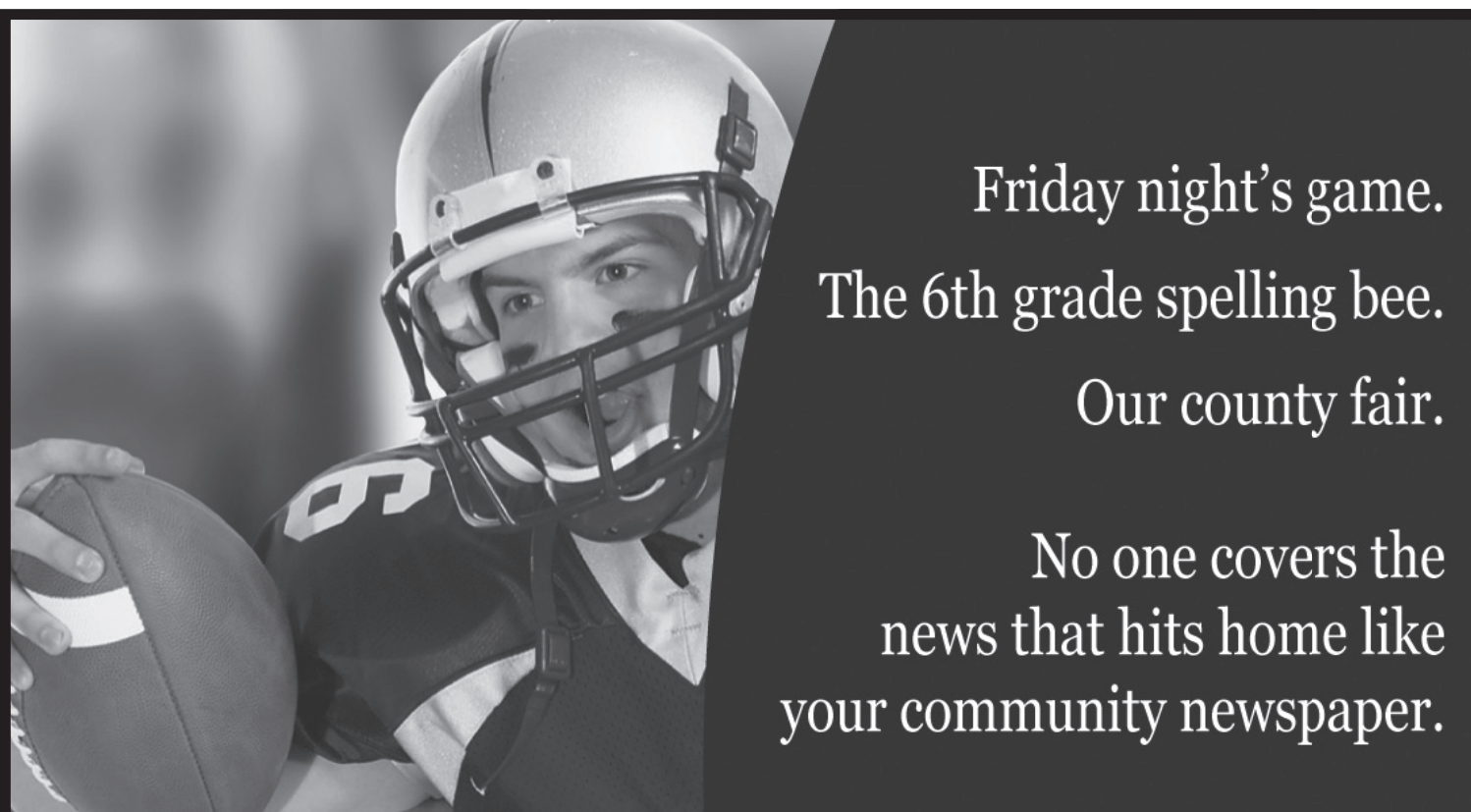
