
After graduation I intend to... definitely go to college, probably either at KU or K-State. I want to be a pharmacist or vet.

My choices of movies, music, books and games (be specific)... Movie: Criminal Minds, Music: Country, Books: Nicholas Sparks


After graduation I intend to... Attend Colby Community College in Criminal Justice, then attend Kansas City Art Institute for Photography.






