Planner - My planner contains my calendar and my lists. My calendar shows both professional and personal time specific actions, day specific actions and day specific information. My lists consist of to-dos, projects, goals, areas of responsibility, ideas and things I'm waiting for. My to-do lists also include a someday/maybe list, a read list, a watch list, and a life list.

Working File - My working file is a traveling file box. I have hanging files titled Act, Read, File, Calendar and Wait. My Act file contains file folders with various projects, a pay file, and a someday/maybe file. My Calendar file contains items related to upcoming events and meetings.

Email Folders - I also have Act, Read, File, Calendar and Wait folders for my email. At the end of the day, I record any needed notes in my planner and empty my inbox by moving emails to the appropriate files. You'll be amazed at how good an empty inbox feels.
