History grants available

The Kansas Historical Society announced that the application deadline for its academic and nonacademic research grants is Sunday, April 15. Grants are intended to help defray expenses while conducting research at the Historical Society in Topeka.

The Alfred M. Landon Historical Research Grant is presented annually to graduate students researching at the State Archives, Kansas Museum of History or the historical society's archeology collections. The total amount available is \$1,000 to be used between Sunday, July 1, and June 30, 2013. Funds are provided by an endowment established in memory of Gov. Landon.

The Edward N. Tihen Historical esearch Grant is presented annually to non-academic researchers to use the collections at the Historical Society. The total amount available is \$500 to be used between July 1 and June 30, 2013. Money is from the Tihen Endowment, established in appreciation of his role as an amateur historian.
