

High school vaulters take first at two meets

It was the pole vault that proved to be the best event for the Goodland High School varsity track teams at the Holcomb meet on April 20 and at Hoisington on April 24.

At Holcomb, Jordan Knitig placed first in the pole vault with a vault of 8 feet. On the boys side, Holton Witman got first place with a vault of 12 feet, 6 inches. However, those were the only Goodland athletes to claim a first place finish.

At Hoisington, Witman again got first place with the exact same height. He also placed fifth in the long jump with 17 feet, 4 inches. Knitig also matched her vault of 8 feet, but came in second.
