The Northwest Tech Maverick men's basketball signed Rolando Armesto to the team in April.

Armesto is a 6 foot, 2 inch shooting/point guard from Puerto Rico and was a member of the U18 national team there. He played AAU basketball for the Miami Tropics, which is a national powerhouse on the AAU circuit. As a senior in high school in Puerto Rico he averaged 25 points per game, 8 rebounds per

game, 7 assists per game.

"Rolando is a very talented player," said coach Jase Herl. "He can attack the basket and can also knock down shots from range."

The team's first game will be Friday, Nov. 2, at the Barton County Classic in Great Bend. They will play in the Ambassador Classic in Colby on Nov. 8, 9 and 10, and the first home game will be against Colby Community College on Tuesday, Nov. 20.
