#### **NOTICE OF PENDING FORFEITURE** Pursuant to K.S.A. 60-4109

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that property herein described has been seized for forfeiture and is pending forfeiture to the Kansas Highway Patrol pursuant to the Kansas Standard Asset Seizure and Forfeiture Act (KSASFA), K.S.A. 60-6041 et seq. If you have not previously received a Notice of Seizure for Forfeiture, this is notice pursuant to the Act. The property was seized by the Kansas Highway Patrol on April 15, 2012, on I-70, in Sherman County, Kansas. The value of the property has been set at \$1,830.00; and the drugs have no lawful value. The conduct giving rise to forfeiture and/or the violation of law alleged is: the property is the proceeds of and/or was used or intended to be used to facilitate violation(s) of illegal drug transactions, all act(s) giving rise to property's forfeiture. Further, a presumption of forfeitability exits in that illegal substances were located in/on the property at seizure.

Should you believe you have a true ownership interest in the seized property, you may do either of the following; (1) File a verified claim with the Court, sending copies to the Plaintiff's Attorney and the Seizing Agency; or (2) Do nothing.

You may also wish to consult with an attorney before deciding what is best for you. However, if no valid claim is timely filed within thirty (30) days of your service of this Notice, your interest in the seized property, if any, will be forfeited. Any claim shall comply with the **strict** requirements of true ownership documentation, as set out in K.S.A. 60-4111.

You should be aware that it is a crime to falsely allege an ownership interest in property or to provide other false information in a claim. Further, pursuant to K.S.A. 60-4116(f), a claimant who fails to establish that a substantial portion of the claimant's interest is exempt from forfeiture may be responsible to pay the reasonable costs. expenses and attorney fees of other claimants and the State.

This Notice seeks claims to the seized property only. Should a valid claim(s) be timely filed as may be determined by the Court upon motion of the State, the State will respond with a judicial petition for forfeiture, and this matter will proceed to trial.

#### **RESOLUTION NO.1360**

A RESOLUTION FINDING THAT THE STRUCTURE LO-CATED AT Lots Three (3) and Six (6); Block Three (3); Goodland Industrial Park which is located in Section Twentyfour (24), Township Eight (8) South, Range Forty (40) West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Sherman County, Kansas. Also known as 601 Industrial Loop, GOODLAND, KANSAS, IS UNSAFE OR DANGEROUS AND DIRECTING THAT THE STRUCTURE BE REPAIRED OR REMOVED AND THE PREMISES BE MADE SAFE AND SECURE.

WHEREAS, the Enforcing Officer of the City of Goodland, Kansas, did on the 6th day of February 2012, file with the governing body of said city, a statement in writing that the structure, hereinafter described, was unsafe and dangerous; and,

WHEREAS, the governing body did by Resolution No. 1357, dated the 19th day of March, 2012, fix the time and place of a hearing at which the owner, his or her agent, and lienholders, any occupants and all other parties of interest of such structure could appear and show cause why such structure should not be condemned and ordered repaired or demolished, and provided for giving notice thereof as provided by law; and,

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 1357 was published in the official city paper on the 23rd day of March, 2012, and on the 30th day of March, 2012, and a copy of said resolution was served upon all persons entitled thereto as provided by law; and,

WHEREAS, on the 7th day of May, 2012, the governing body did conduct the hearing scheduled in Resolution No. 1357 and took evidence from the following: the Enforcing Officer on behalf of the City and the Owner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERN-ING BODY OF THE CITY OF GOODLAND, KANSAS, THAT:

1. The governing body hereby finds that the structure located at Lots Three (3) and Six (6); Block Three (3); Goodland Industrial Park which is located in Section Twenty-four (24), Township Eight (8) South, Range Forty (40) West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Sherman County, Kansas. Also known as 601 Industrial Loop, is unsafe and dangerous and directs that such structure is to be repaired and the premises made safe and secure.

The owner of such structure is hereby directed to commence the repair of the property within ninety (90) days of May 7, 2012. Provided that upon due application by the owner and for good cause shown, the governing body, in its sole discretion, may grant the owner additional time to complete the repairs to the property.

If the owner fails to commence the repair of the structure within the time stated, or any additional time granted by the governing body, or fails to diligently prosecute the same until the work is completed, the governing body will cause the structure to be razed and removed and the costs of razing and removing, less salvage, if any, shall be collected in the manner provided by K.S.A. 12-1,1115, and amendments thereto or shall be assessed as special assessments against the lot or parcel of land upon which the structure is located or both, all as provided by law.

BEITFURTHER RESOLVED, that if the owner fails to commence the repair of the structure within the time provided herein or fails to diligently prosecute the same, the governing body may take such further action as it deems necessary to raise and remove the structure without further notice to the owner or other parties in interest.

BEITFURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk shall cause

this Resolution to be published once in the official city paper and mail a copy to the owners, agents, lienholders, occupants and other parties in interest.
