May's exhibit features local graphic arts student

May's exhibit at the Carnegie Arts Center includes the work of a graphic art student at Northwest Kansas Technical College in Goodland and a professional photographer, writer and landscape contractor from Walden, Colo.

Rusty Wickham is a student at the Technical College and has studied graphic art for four years in high

school. On display are up-cycled items (redesigned finds), photography, sketching, graphic design, painting, vinyls, t-shirt designs and layouts. Wickham is always striving to do better than his previous artwork.

Walden native Dale Petefish's photography show his great love of the wilderness and its inhabit-

ants. He enjoys traveling the back country on foot or horseback in the 160,000 acres of Colorado's Mt. Zirkle wilderness. He runs his own bow-hunting and back-country survival school. In 2001 he was the Colorado Bow Hunter of the Year.

Some of the photos in the exhibit are landscapes of the mountains; pictures of elk, moose and other

inhabitants of the wilderness and native Americans. He cut the mats and makes the frames for his photos.

Petefish has won several award and his art is displayed in nine galleries throughout Montana, Wyoming, Colorado and Kansas.

He will be a guest from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. for Sack Lunch Thursday at Carnegie Arts. He will do a book

signing for his newest book, "The Essence of Mt. Zirkle Wilderness." The book is a coffee table, hardback book of 100 full-color pages on the beauty of the 160,000 acre Mt. Zirkle Wilderness. It includes poetry and writings about some of the history of the area.

Petefish will be a guest speaker at a Photography Roundtable special

meeting from 5 to 6 p.m. the same day. The public is invited.

At the opening of the exhibit on Sunday Sarah Dexter and Elwyn Vatcher painted to readings of Petefish's other book "Wonderings."
