County on Sunday. According to a Kansas Highway Patrol report, one of the bikers hit the breaks and four vehicles couldn't slow down in time and crashed, ending up in both lanes of the interstate.

Dale Queenan, 52, and Marcia Bourke, 48, both of Maryland, Australia, were taken to Goodland Regional Medical Center with disabling injuries. They had been riding the same motorcycle. Both were flown to St. Anthony's Hospi-

tal in Denver.

Michael Kenyon, 67, of Mesa, Ariz., was also taken to the Goodland hospital.

Larry Kosnik, 65, of LaPorte, Ind., and Karen Williams, 68, of Sun Lakes, Ariz., were taken to Colby. Williams was flown to Swedish Medical Center in Denver. The driver of the fourth vehicle, Michael Robertson, 63, of Inyokern, Calif., was not injured.

The accident happened about 17 miles east of Goodland.

to file for re-election. County Attorney Brock Abbey and newly appointed Treasurer April Hall also plan to file for the primary election.

Two people have filed for township positions including Carolyn Paul for McPherson Township treasurer and Joyce Purvis for McPherson Township trustee.

Numerous Republicans have filed for party committee positions: Michael Bretz for Ward 1 committeeman; Roberta Bretz for Ward 1 committeewoman; Judith Vignery for Fourth Precinct committeewoman; J. Ronald Vignery for Fourth Precinct committeeman; Carol Topliff for Logan Township committeewoman; Joyce Purvis for McPherson Township committeewoman; Elmer

Purvis for McPherson Township committeeman; Karen Hooker for Stateline Township committeewoman; Allen Quenzer for Union Township committeeman; Doris Quenzer for Union Township committeewoman; Kendall Gittinger for Ward Four committeeman; Betty Schields for Voltaire Township committeewoman; and David Schields for Voltaire Township committeeman.

Sen. Ralph Ostmeyer of Grinnell has filed for re-election in the 40th Senate District, which includes Sherman County. Challenging him for the Republican nomination is John Miller, a Norton County commissioner.

Rep. Rick Billinger of Goodland has filed for re-election in the 121st House District. he is currently unchallenged.

All four of Kansas' seats in the U.S. House of

Representatives, but according to the latest list from the Kansas Secretary of State's office, no one has filed.

Two district court judges, Scott Showalter of Goodland and Todd Stramel of Colby will be up for retention this year as well as magistrate judges Mark Tamaat of Oakley, John Cahoj of Hoxie, Steve Unruh of Sharon Springs and Richard Ress of Colby.

The primary election is for party candidates, independents can file for the general election after the primary election has concluded. Rumpel said there is no space for write-ins on the primary ballots. Anyone wishing to mount a write-in campaign in the general election should file with county clerk, since there is substantial interest paperwork to be filled out.
