

Goodland plays host to league swim meet

The Goodland Swim Team was at their home pool for the Northwest Kansas Swim League Championship meet on Friday and Saturday and won by a large margin with 355.5 points. Some of the races were very close.

Swimmers set three individual pool records, won 19 individual races and won five relay with two of the setting records. Sixteen swimmers won high point trophies for the season. Four swimmers with league champions for the two-day meet.

Ethan McDaniel (8 and under boys) was a league champion with 33 points and won four events; the 50-yard freestyle (37.73), the 25-yard freestyle (16.98), the 25-yard butterfly (22.63) and setting the record in the 100-yard individual medley (1:44.70), a new pool record. He also placed second in the 25-yard breaststroke (25.38).

Devinee Borgmann (11-12 girls) also won the league championship with 33 points. She won four races; the 100-yard freestyle (1:10.84), the 50-yard freestyle (31.25), the 50-yard breaststroke (40.86) and setting a new pool record in the 50-yard butterfly (33.13). Borgmann also placed second in the individual medley (1:20.22).

Dusty Johnson (13-14 boys) was the other record setter, winning the 100-yard backstroke (1:14.26).

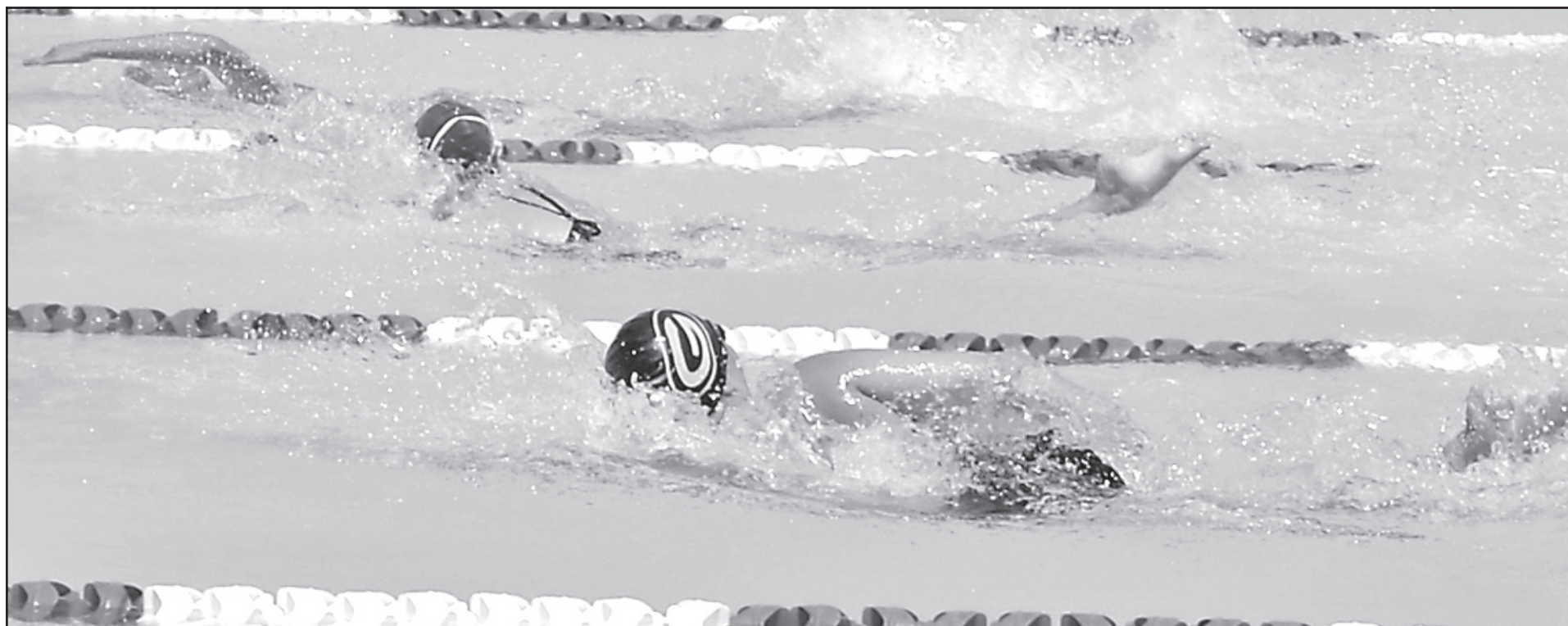
Rachel Witman (9-10 girls) won two races; the 25-yard backstroke (19.55) and the 25-yard butterfly (17.58). She scored 26 points to win a league championship trophy.

Levi House (11-12 boys) was also a league champion winning two races; the 100-yard freestyle (1:10.79) and the 100-yard individual medley (1:28.14) and scoring 26 points.

Others winning one race each were Mya Nemechek (8 and under girls) in the 25-yard butterfly (25.90), Lindsey Cure (8 and under girls) in the 25-yard freestyle (18.74), Gantzen Miller (8 and under boys) in the 25-yard backstroke (23.73), Leyton Cure (9-10 boys) in the 25-yard freestyle (15.11), Peyton Sieck (11-12 boys) 200-yard freestyle (2:51.34) and Taryn Bedore (15-18 girls) in the 100-yard butterfly (1:15.44).

The 8 and under boys 100-yard medley relay team set a new record (1:45.35) with Linkon Cure, Gantzen Miller, Ethan McDaniel and Devontey Hardy swimming.

Other relay winners were the 8 and under boys 100-yard freestyle A team (1:28.39) with Ethan McDaniel, Gantzen Miller, Linkon Cure and Hardy; the 11-12 mixed 200-yard freestyle (2:15.78) with Hannah Eslinger, Teryn Teeter, Austin Hahn and Champ King; and

the 15-18 mixed 200-yard medley (2:14.14) with Dusty Johnson, Coy Johnson, Aaron Avelar and Holton Witman.

High point winners for the season, placings and points were in 8 and under girls Lindsey Cure second with 85 points and Nemechek third with 71 points; in 8 and under boys Ethan McDaniel first with 138 points and Gantzen Miller fifth with 66 points; in 9-10 girls Rachel Witman first with 115 points; in 9-10 boys Leyton Cure was sixth with 63 points; in 11-12 girls Borgmann second with 85 points, Chalee Luther third with 82 points and Ellie McDaniel fifth with 59 points; in 11-12 boys House was first with 125 points and Peyton Sieck second with 92 points; in 13-14 boys Dusty Johnson was third with 104 points and Hagan Hoss fourth with 88 points; in 15-18 girls Taryn Bedore tied for first with 95 points; and in 15-18 boys Ian Bonsall was fifth with 81 points and Holton Witman sixth with 77 points.

In 8 and under girls Nemechek was also second in the 50-yard freestyle (41.74), second in the 25-yard freestyle (19.01) and second in the 25-yard backstroke (23.47) and Lindsey Cure was fourth in the 50-yard freestyle (45.17), fourth in the 25-yard backstroke (24.62) and fifth in the 25-yard butterfly (30.20).

The 8 and under girls was third in the 100-yard freestyle relay (1:32.30) with Lindsey Cure, Olivia Bassett, Sydney Hahn and Nemechek swimming.

In 8 and under boys Gantzen Miller was third in the 25-yard free-

style (19.20), sixth in the 25-yard breaststroke (37.19) and fourth in the 100-yard individual medley (2:13.53); Hardy was fifth in the 50-yard freestyle (47.92), fourth in the 25-yard freestyle (2.89) and fourth in the 25-yard butterfly (28.28); and Dexter Dautel was fifth in the 25-yard breaststroke (36.79).

The 8 and under boys B team was fifth in the 100-yard freestyle relay (1:56.40) with Cole Linton, Eli Greene, Dautel and Blair Linin swimming.

The 8 and under mixed 100-yard medley was third (2:01.74) with Sydney Hahn, Nemechek, Lindsey Cure and Blair Linin swimming.

In 9-10 girls Rachel Witman was fourth in the 100-yard freestyle (1:25.53), second in the 25-yard breaststroke (22.42) and second in the 100-yard individual medley (1:34.55) and Peri Sieck was third in the 100-yard freestyle (1:25.41), fourth in the 25-yard freestyle (16.78), fourth in the 25-yard backstroke (20.53) and sixth in the 100-yard individual medley (1:39.88).

The 9-10 girls 100-yard freestyle relay was second (1:13.25) with Rachel Witman, Peri Sieck, Rebecca Lockhart and Lauren Cure swimming.

The 9-10 girls 100-yard medley was third (1:32.79) with Rachel Witman, Lauren Cure, Rebecca Lockhart and Annika Linin swimming.

In 9-10 boys Leyton Cure was fourth in the 100-yard freestyle (1:25.55), second in the 25-yard breaststroke (22.95) and fifth in the 100-yard individual medley

(1:51.25). The 9-10 mixed 100-yard freestyle relay was fourth (1:27.22) with Leyton Cure, Walker Eslinger, Truman Hooker and Annika Linin swimming.

The 9-10 mixed 100-yard medley was sixth (1:49.59) with Linton, Leyton Cure, Peri Sieck and Dautel swimming.

In 11-12 girls Luther was fourth in the 100-yard freestyle (1:11.81), third in the 50-yard freestyle (31.92), second in the 50-yard backstroke (38.10), fourth in the 50-yard breaststroke (43.74) and fourth in the 100-yard individual medley (1:26.85); Ellie McDaniel was sixth in the 100-yard freestyle (1:13.65), fourth in the 50-yard butterfly (40.90) and sixth in the 100-yard individual medley (1:30.52); Kaitlyn Townsend was fourth in the 200-yard freestyle (1:15.65); and Hannah Eslinger was sixth in the 200-yard freestyle (3:40.34).

The 11-12 girls 100-yard freestyle relay was third (2:23.23) with Luther, Townsend, Ellie McDaniel and Borgman swimming.

The 11-12 girls 200-yard medley was second (2:44.72) with Townsend, Chalee Luther, Borgman and Ellie McDaniel swimming.

In 11-12 boys House was also second in the 50-yard freestyle (31.55), second in the 50-yard butterfly (39.42) and fifth in the 50-yard breaststroke (47.99); Peyton Sieck was also fourth in the 100-yard freestyle (1:15.70), third in the

50-yard freestyle (31.95) and third in the 100-yard individual medley (1:30.60); Powell Sieck was sixth in the 50-yard freestyle (34.82) and third in the 50-yard backstroke (43.11); and Chase Johnson was fourth in the 200-yard freestyle (3:10.25).

The 11-12 boys 200-yard freestyle relay was fourth (2:51.69) with House, Chase Johnson, Peyton Sieck and Ryan Volk swimming.

In 13-14 girls Sianna Miller was sixth in the 50-yard freestyle (30.38) and sixth in the 100-yard backstroke (1:34.22).

In 13-14 boys Dusty Johnson was second in the 400-yard freestyle (5:23.94), second in the 200-yard freestyle (2:31.80), third in the 100-yard breaststroke (1:25.60) and second in the 200-yard individual medley (2:51.30); Hoss was fifth in the 400-yard freestyle (6:01.24), sixth in the 200-yard freestyle (2:47.53), second in the 100-yard freestyle (1:06.42), third in the 50-yard freestyle (28.23) and second in the 100-yard butterfly (1:21.59); and Simon Bassett was sixth in the 100-yard breaststroke (1:32.68).

The 13-14 boys 200-yard freestyle relay was second with Dusty Johnson, Simon Bassett, Hoss and Powell Sieck swimming.

The 13-14 mixed 200-yard medley was second (2:48.80) with Hannah Eslinger, Sianna Miller, Hoss and Peyton Sieck swimming.

In 15-18 girls Bedore was fourth in the 200-yard freestyle (2:29.75),

second in the 100-yard freestyle (1:01.76), second in the 50-yard freestyle (27.04) and second in the 100-yard backstroke (1:14.77).

In 15-18 boys Holton Witman was third in the 100-yard freestyle (1:00.53), second in the 50-yard freestyle (25.74), third in the 100-yard butterfly (1:09.21) and fourth in the 100-yard breaststroke (1:25.22); Avelar was fourth in the 400-yard freestyle (6:04.36), sixth in the 200-yard freestyle (2:40.56) and fifth in the 100-yard backstroke (1:29.31); Gerell Miller was fourth in the 100-yard freestyle (1:01.53) and fifth in the 200-yard individual medley (2:55.33); and Coy Johnson was fifth in the 100-yard breaststroke (1:35.49).

The 15-18 mixed 200-yard freestyle relay was fourth (2:05.27) with Brooke Lockhart, Coy Johnson, Avelar and Holton Witman swimming.

Others swimming were Paetyn Barriclow, Lindsey Geeska, Kinsey Volk, Kyndell King, Savannah Bassett, Makayla Kennedy and Rachel Horney.

The Burlington Swim Team was second with 225, Holyoke Swim Club third with 212 points, Colby Swim Club fourth with 202 points, Oberlin Swim Club fifth with 199 points, Wray Swim Club sixth with 198 points, Oakley Swim Team seventh with 79 points and Flagler Swim Team was eighth with 38.5 points.
