Notice Concerning Proposed Kansas Air Quality Class I Operating Permit

Notice is hereby given that the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) is soliciting comments regarding a proposed air quality operating permit. Northern Sun Co. A Division. of Archer Daniel Midland Company has applied for a Class I operating permit in accordance with the provisions of K.A.R. 28-19-510 et al. The purpose of a Class I permit is to identify the sources and types of regulated air pollutants emitted from the facility; the emission limitations, standards and requirements applicable to each source; and the monitoring, record keeping and reporting requirements applicable to each source as of the effective date of permit issuance.

Northern Sun Co. A Division of Archer Daniel Midland Company, 6425 State Road 14, Goodland, Kansas 67735, owns and operates Vegetable Oilseed Processing located at 6425 State Road 14, Goodland Kan-

A copy of the proposed permit, permit application, all supporting documentation, and all information relied upon during the permit application review process are available for a 30 day public review during normal business hours at the KDHE, Bureau of Air and Radiation (BAR), 1000 SW Jackson, Suite 310, Topeka, KS 66612-1366. Also a copy of the proposed permit only can be reviewed at the Northwest District Office, 2301 East 13th, Street, Hays, Kansas 67601-2651. The standard departmental cost will be assessed for any copies requested.

SW Jackson, Suite 310, Topeka, KS 66612-1366, (785) 291-3278. In order to be considered in formulating a final permit decision written comments must be received. no later than the close of business on February 2, 2004.

A person may request a public hearing be held on the proposed permit. The request for a public hearing shall be in writing and set forth the basis for the request. The written request must be submitted to Donna Reno, BAR., KDHE, 1000 SW Jackson, Suite 310, Topeka, KS 66612-1366, no later than the close of business on February 2, 2004 in order for the Secretary of Health and Environment to consider the request.

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) has a 45 day review period, which will start concurrently with the 30 day public comment period, within which to object to the proposed permit. If the USEPA has not objected in writing to the issuance of the permit within the 45 day review period, any person may petition the administrator of the USEPA to review the permit. The 60 day public petition period will directly

follow the. USEPA 45 day review period. If the USEPA waives their 45 day review period, the 60 day public petition period will start directly after the 30 day public comment period. Interested parties may contact KDHE to determine if the USEPA 45-day review period has been waived.

Any such petition shall be based only on objections to the permit that were raised with reasonable specificity during the public comment period provided for in this notice, unless the petitioner demonstrates that it was impracticable to raise such objections within such period, or unless the grounds for such objection arose after such period. Contact Gary Schlicht, USEPA, Region VII, Air Permitting and Compliance Branch, 901 N. 5th Street, Kansas City, Kansas 66101, (913) 551-7097, to determine when the 45 day USEPA review period ends and the 60 day petition period commences.

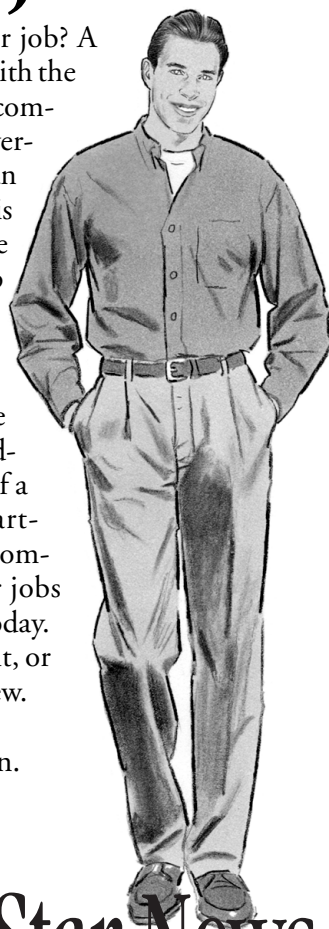
