

County to get new weed spray truck in the spring

 Sherman County will have a new weed spray truck this spring, and Tuesday the commissioners approved the bids for the truck bed and equipment.
 Daryl West head of the county noxious weed department met with the commissioners in December

and they approved the purchase of a new spray truck with the truck and chassis coming from Dan Brenner Ford at a cost of \$33,550.
 West said he had talked to Gary Farris of Farris Manufacturing about building the truck bed, and told the commissioners that the estimated cost is \$2,760 for building the bed. He said there would be a

small additional cost for the purchase of the lights, and Farris had said he would purchase and install the lights as part of building the bed.
 There were two companies West had found to install the spray equipment. One was in Wichita and the other in Garden City. West said the Garden City firm bid \$7,748 while the Wichita firm's costs was \$8,928.

West said he felt the spray equipment from the firm in Wichita would be more durable than the Garden City firm.
 "Either one will work," West said, "but I would feel more comfortable with the one from Wichita, and he has been quite a bit of help to me."
 "Both firms do good work, but the one in Wichita does more industrial type spraying designs while the one in Garden City is more of an agriculture design."
 Commissioner Kevin Rasure made the motion to have Farris Manufacturing build the truck bed and to purchase the spray equipment through Vegetation Management Service of Wichita. The motion passed unanimously with

Commissioners Chuck Thomas and Mitch Tiede voting in favor.
 West said he expects the truck to be ready by April, and he said Brenner thought the county could get about \$4,000 out of the old spray truck. West said he will place ads locally and in a statewide noxious weed newsletter as soon as the new truck is in operation.
