# Statistics on physical child abuse staggering

The statistics on physical child abuse are alarming. It is estimated hundreds of thousands of children are physically abused each year by a parent or close relative.

Thousands die. For those who survive, the emotional trauma remains long after the external bruises have healed.

Communities and the courts recognize that these emotional "hidden bruises" can be treated. Early recognition and treatment is important to minimize the long-term effect of physical abuse.


