

Kid wrestlers busy with tournament action

Goodland's wrestling club was represented at three tournaments Saturday, Jan. 31, in Ellis, Salina and Caney.

At the tournament in Ellis, Jed Gray placed second at 52 pounds in the eight and under category. James Dinkel finished fourth at 55 pounds.

In the 10 and under group, Seth Miller took second at 70 pounds and Tyler Fisher fourth at 120. Teather Dautel earned second at 84 pounds in the 12 and under category.

In Salina, Aaron Avelar and Brook Bahe competed in the eight and under group at 43 and 67 pounds respectively. Austin Avelar at 58 pounds and Laine Herl at 110 pounds competed in the 10 and under category.

Saturday the Osburn family headed to Caney, Kan., about 60 miles straight north from Tulsa, Okla. for a tournament there. In the 12 and under category, Jacob placed third at 72 pounds as did Joel at 110. Joseph took fourth at 92 pounds the same weight class Jonathan also competed in. Noah wrestled at 37 pounds in the six and under group.

Wrestlers from Goodland also competed at two tournaments Saturday, Jan. 24, one in Atwood and the other in Phillipsburg.

Most of the Kansas Kids from Goodland went to Atwood. In the 6-year-old and under category, Ricky Milke won first place and Josh David placed third at 49 pounds. Simon Bassett took second at 40 pounds. At 37 pounds, Noah Osburn placed second and Jordan Raby third.

Goodland had three first-place finishers in the 8 and under group: Colton Cooper at 64 pounds, Bahe at 67 pounds and Ian Bonsall at 88 pounds. John Peden placed second at 67 pounds and Garrett Taylor third at 73 pounds. Tyler Raby finished fourth at 61 pounds. Cody Hooker and Alex Nelson both competed at 76 pounds.

In the 10 and under category, Austin Avelar earned first place at 58 pounds. Mikail Freeman (73 pounds), Miller (70 pounds), Fisher (120 pounds) and Jason Cowan (90 pounds) each finished second. Thern Bagley was third at 90 pounds.

Joel Osburn took first at 110 pounds in the 12 and under group. Finishing second were Jacob Osburn at 72 pounds, Joseph Osburn at 92 and Tim Roeder at 100. Dautel (84), Erik Roeder (92), Chance Davis (96) and Paul Starr (115) placed third. Jonathan Osburn was fourth at 92 pounds.

Three Goodland wrestlers competed in Phillipsburg. Laine Herl won first place at 110 pounds in the 10 and under category. Taylen Smith took second in the heavy-weight class for 8 and under and Kelby Smith was second at 43 pounds in the 6 and under group.

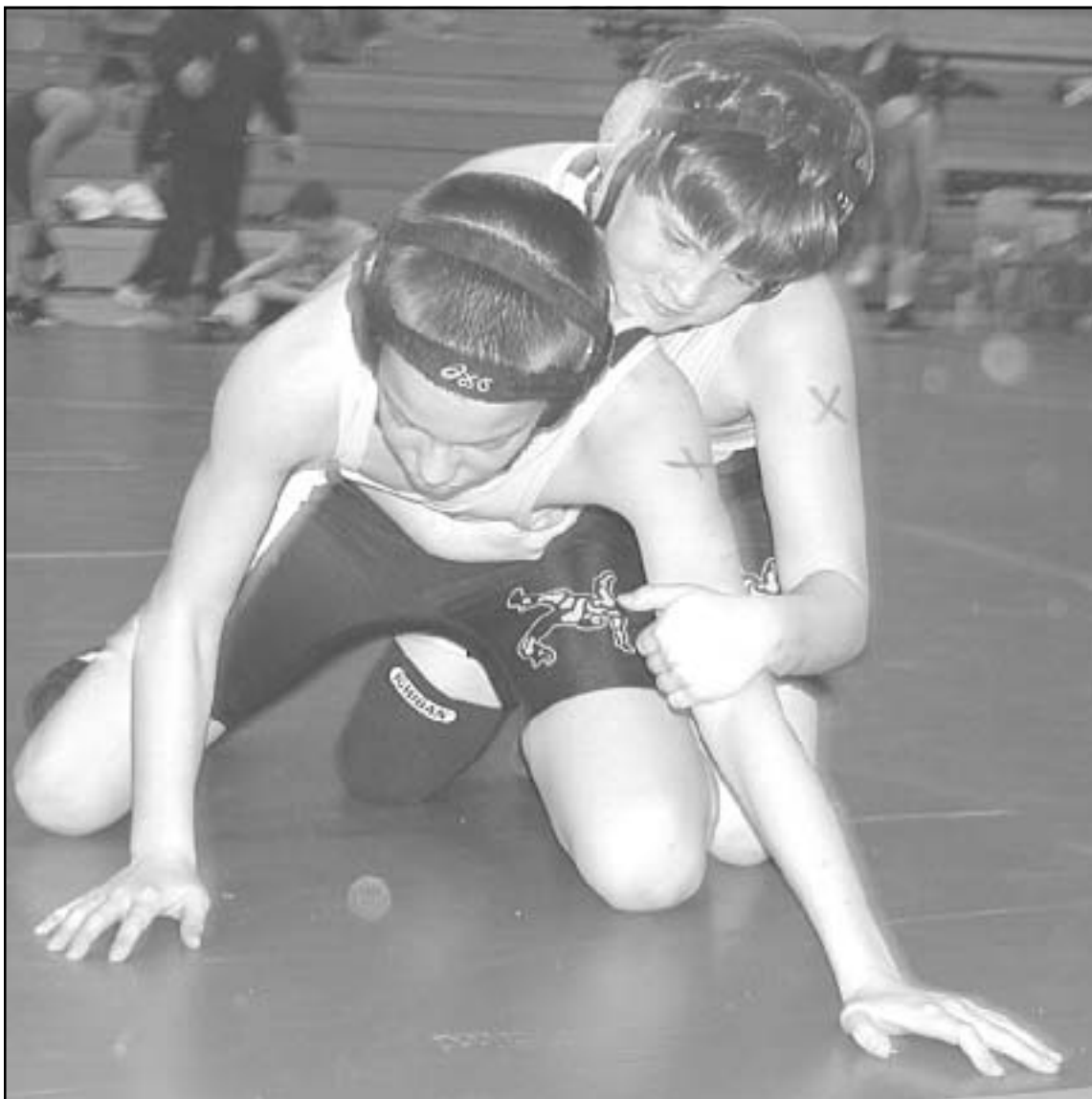
