The Goodland Star-News The Goodland High Cowgirls came close to pulling off a dramatic comeback Tuesday against the Lady Broncos of Lakin, but the lastminute effort fell short, and they lost 70-60

Friday, the Cowgirls will face the Lady Plainsmen of Oakley at 5:30 p.m. at Max Jones Fieldhouse, as they move into the final stretch of the season. The loss Tuesday left them with a 9-7 record.

"I expect this to be a good game," said Coach Terry Daise. "Oakley has one fast guard; they have a good girl who is averaging 18-19 per game. They have five good starters and will be a challenge for us. They are the only team who has beaten Hoxie this year."

Dani Bedore gave the home crowd a few minutes of apprehension late in the first quarter when she was fouled as she went up for a basket and went crashing to the floor. Emergency Medical Technician Bruce Gleason and the Goodland coaches gathered around her, and it took a few minutes before she got to her feet and was helped off the court.

She walked around to make sure everything was OK and put some ice on her knee for a few minutes. She returned to the game in the second quarter and scored 4 of her total of 21 points in that period.

"She did not practice on Wednesday," Coach Daise said. "We will have to see if she is ready to play tonight. She is a tough kid, but that was quite a fall she took."
