In accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 79-1476, the Division of Property Valuation is required to annually furnish each county the results of itsí study relating to changes, if any, of the use value of agricultural land. Changes can and do occur as a result of several factors including cropping practices, commodity prices and production costs.

The study relating to use value of Agricultural Land completed by the Division of Property Valuation indicated the following changes compared to the prior year.

All Grassland: majority of soil	Decrease of \$3.00 to \$5.00 per/acre on mapping units

Dry Cropland: Decrease of \$0.00 to \$5.00 per/acre on majority of soil mapping units

Irrigated Cropland: Decrease of \$4.00 to \$10.00 per/acre on predominate irrigated soil mapping units
