

# Colby splits doubleheader with Seward County

The Colby Community College softball team split a doubleheader against Seward County Community College on Tuesday, winning the first game 8-7 and losing the second by the same score.

In the first game, freshman Christina Obernolte pitched all seven innings, giving up six hits, striking out three and walked four. The Lady Trojans got 12 hits, led by sophomore Calea Meyer and freshman Lauren Jameson who both went three of four at the plate.

The second game was tied 7-7 at the end of seven innings, but the Lady Saints stepped up and scored, then kept Colby from scoring to earn the win. Sophomore Lindsey Kastanek took the loss, pitching a complete game. Former Cowgirl

Shanae Calkins went two for three at the plate and drove in three runs. Colby had nine hits in the game.

“We are playing better each time out,” Coach Carl Adams said. “We are more focused on hitting as a team and not as individuals. We still need our pitchers to continue to step up and get better.”

The Lady Trojans finished second in the Colby Classic last weekend, going 4-2 for the tournament.

Colby opened the tournament Saturday with a 6-5 win over McCook Community College in eight innings. Kastanek pitched all eight innings, striking out nine and gave up no walks. The Trojans had 16 hits, led by sophomore Alisha Liess, who went three of four at the plate and drove in two runs.

Colby got 11 hits in its second game Saturday, but the Trojans fell 8-7 to the Cougars of Western Nebraska Community College. Calkins got hits on all three turns at bat, driving in a run.

In their final game Saturday, the Trojans defeated Trinidad State Junior College of Colorado 10-6. Kastanek, who pitched all seven innings, earned her second win of the tournament, striking out four and again not allowing a walk. Colby had 12 hits in the game, led by Liess, who went four of four. Jameson went three of four and drove in three runs.

Like the day before, Colby started Sunday with a one-run victory over McCook, this time 7-6. Kastanek got her third win for the week-

end, striking out three while pitching the first four innings. Freshman Corri Ball pitched the final three innings for a save, striking out three. Sophomore Dani Wolf went three of four at the plate to lead the Trojans.

In the semifinals Colby shut out Trinidad State 4-0. Kastanek pitched her third complete game and earned her fourth win for the tournament. She struck out nine batters, walked four and allowed five hits. Meyer led the Trojans at the plate, going three for four and driving in two runs.

In the championship game, Colby again faced Western Nebraska and again the Cougars came out on top, 9-8. Meyer got three hits in four trips to the plate, including

a home run, and drove in five runs. Wolf and Liess got three hits each.

“We had some people step up and hit the ball,” Adams said, “but we still have people that need to come out ready to play every game.”

The Trojans are 7-3 in their last 10 games. On March 25, Colby swept a doubleheader against Butler County Community College, winning the first 4-1 and the second 12-7. Obernolte was the winning pitcher in the first game, throwing a complete game. Meyer went three for four at the plate, including two doubles, to lead the team.

Ball was the winning pitcher in the second game against the Lady Grizzlies. Wolf got three hits, including a grand slam and a double, in four turns at bat and drove in five

runs. Calkins hit a three-run homer in the fourth inning.

The girls are 12-23 overall for the season and 4-6 in the West Division of the Kansas Jayhawk Community College Conference. The Lady Trojans were to have played a doubleheader Thursday against Barton County Community College in Colby and will play in the Jayhawk Challenge tournament in Wichita this Saturday and Sunday.

“This is a weird year,” said Adams. “Everyone is getting beat. There are no team dominating like in years past. The conference and region are wide open; whatever team gets hot this weekend has a great shot to win regionals and get to the nationals.”

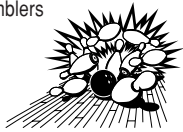

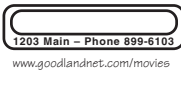
