


# Cowgirls split doubleheader with Colby

The Cowgirls softball team split a doubleheader against Colby High School Thursday, winning the first game 6-4 and losing the second 14-9.


The Lady Eagles took a 1-0 lead in the bottom of the first inning, but Goodland came back in the top of the second when freshman Whitney Archer hit a triple that drove in two runs. Then Colby tied the game at 2 in the bottom of the third.

The Cowgirls scored three runs in the fourth to take a 5-2 lead and added another in the sixth. Colby scored two runs in the bottom of the seventh to make the final 6-4.

Archer led the team at the plate, getting a triple and a double in five trips to the plate. She drove in four runs and scored one herself. Both senior Cortney Schields and sophomore Chelsea Gray went two of four, and both hit a double. Schields scored

two runs and Gray drove in one. Seniors Tomi Windell and Jennifer Mentzer and sophomore Justeen Koehler all went one of four at the plate. Both Mentzer and Koehler scored runs. Sophomore Jordan Frazier scored a run while pinch running for senior pitcher Lauren Gray.

Gray earned her first win of the season, pitching all seven innings. She gave up six hits, struck out four and walked two. She is 1-1 for the season.

"Lauren pitched a great game," said Coach Terry Daise. "We played good defense and got some key hits

when we needed them."

In the second game, the Eagles took advantage of four Goodland errors in the first inning to take an early lead which they kept throughout the game. Both teams scored a run in the second inning.

In the top of the third inning, the Cowgirls scored a pair of runs, but Colby responded with three runs in the bottom of the inning to make the score 8-3. Goodland scored a run in the top of the fourth, but again the Eagles responded with three runs to increase their lead to 11-4.

The Cowgirls outscored Colby 2-1 in the fifth inning and 3-2 in the

sixth to make it 14-9, but the Eagle defense held Goodland scoreless in the seventh inning for the win.

Senior Deanna Thompson got two hits in four plate appearances, a triple and a double. She scored three runs and drove one in. Koehler also went two of four at the plate.

Chelsea Gray, Archer and Mentzer each hit a single and scored a run. Windell scored two runs, one after getting on base with a single in the fifth and the other after walking in the sixth. Sophomore Melissa Swager scored after being walked in the second inning. Lauren Gray hit a single in her only turn at bat.

The loss went to Thompson, who gave four runs in the first on one hit, three walks and a hit batter. Four Goodland errors contributed to the Eagles scoring spurt.


"We just got off to a bad start and just couldn't catch up," Daise said. "We had to change pitchers in the first inning and used three in the game. Also, we made too many errors."

The Cowgirls, in fact, committed nine errors in the second game.

Goodland, now 1-3 for the season, will play the Lady Buffaloes of Garden City High School Tuesday at Centennial Park in a doubleheader starting at 3 p.m.
