

Rattlesnakes found in car

Last Thursday, Mr. Richards entered a guilty plea in city court. He

was fined \$100 and court costs. Chief Lockhart requested the Police Chief Wade Lockhart said right to inspect Mr. Richards' house for snakes. Chief Lockhart said he wasn't very willing for the inspection. The police agreed to give him an hour before going to the house.

He said Mr. Richards said he was keeping them not as pets, but to use to make hat bands and belts.

'We can't tolerate having something like that in the city," said Chief Chief Lockhart took the snakes Lockhart. "It is a safety issue."


