dents attended a leadership meeting and participated in workshops and sessions that allowed them to accept the challenges of being members today but leaders tomor-


About 2,000 members, advisers and guests from across the state attended the leadership meeting.

The organization's programs are planned and run by members, and participation helps members to become strong leaders in their families, careers and communities.












