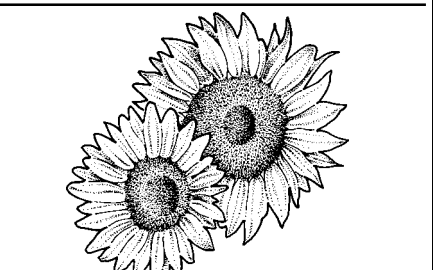

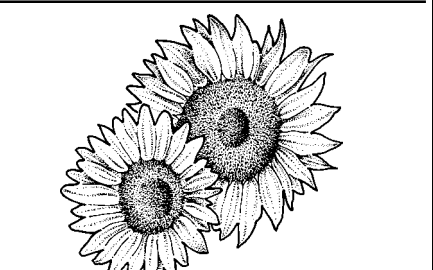

Seven Goodland students earn top score, qualify for national competition in July

Seven Goodland High School students have earned the opportunity to represent the state at the national Family, Career and Community Leaders of America meeting in Chicago this summer.

Freshmen Jared Hall, Michael Smith, Tyler Anderson, Ashley Cebula, Sandy Johnson, Vanessa Crotinger and Lea Shores received a gold for Parliamentary Procedure at the state leadership showcase and earned the top score, qualifying them to represent the state.

Smith was also selected to serve on the state FCCLA board for the next two years.

Thirty-three Goodland students attended the "Accept the Challenge" showcase Sunday-Tuesday, April 4-6, in Wichita, and all who competed in the Students Taking Action for Recognition

(STAR) events earned gold.

Sophomores Julian Walls, Matt Rohr, Brett Lalicker, Aaron Duell, Kaitlin Lee, Katrina Cotter, Sami Philbrick and Jordan Frazier received gold for Parliamentary Procedure, and Andrea Grieve received gold for Creed.

For Parliamentary Procedure, teams demonstrate how to run a meeting correctly; for Creed, students give a one-minute interpretation of the organization's creed.

Advisors Sarah Short and Gwen Cebula accompanied the students.

The seven Goodland freshmen are planning a trip to Chicago for the national event Sunday-Thursday, July 11-15, and are looking for donations to pay for the trip.

Besides the competitions at state, stu-

dents attended a leadership meeting and participated in workshops and sessions that allowed them to accept the challenges of being members today but leaders tomorrow.

About 2,000 members, advisers and guests from across the state attended the leadership meeting.

Members listened to keynote speaker Barrett Keene, who talked about love, character and passion. And students had the opportunity to connect to other sessions of their choice, including financial fitness, leadership, career decisions and STOP the Violence.

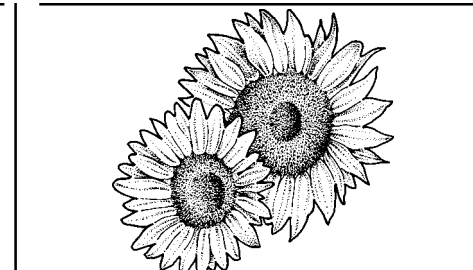
The organization's programs are planned and run by members, and participation helps members to become strong leaders in their families, careers and communities.

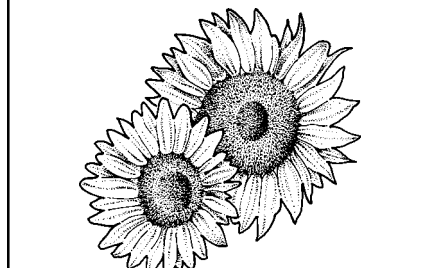

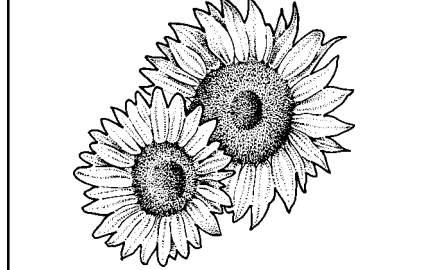
