

Tennis team in Colby today

The Goodland High School boys tennis team will see its final action of the regular season today at 3 p.m. (Central Time) at Colby High School.

On Saturday, the Cowboys had a rough time at the Garden City Invitational, finishing last in a 10-team field. The team of junior D.J. Sparks and sophomore Brandon Zelfer placed sixth at No. 1 doubles with a 3-2 record.

The No. 2 doubles team of sophomore Julian Wells and freshman Jared Hall finished eighth with a 1-4 record. Freshman Josh Cech playing at No. 1 singles went 0-5 and finished 10th. Goodland did not enter a player at No. 2 singles.

Garden City won the tournament, followed by Dodge City and Great Bend.

Last Friday, the Cowboys finished fourth in the Goodland Invitational, which had been postponed from April 22 due to weather. Zelfer went 4-0 and finished first at No. 2 singles. Cech was third at No. 1 singles, 2-2 for the tournament.

Both of the Cowboys' doubles teams were fourth, ending the day 1-3. Hurst teamed up with Sparks at No. 1 doubles, and Walls and Hall paired up at No. 2.

The Tigers of Ulysses High won the tournament with 31 points, fol-

lowed by Colby with 27. Garden City was third with 23 points. Goodland scored 19. Scott City finished fifth.

Last Thursday, the Cowboys finished third at a tournament at Hays High School. Cech at No. 1 singles, Zelfer at No. 2 singles and the team

of Hurst and Sparks at No. 1 doubles all finished 2-2 and placed third. Wells and Hall at No. 2 doubles were fourth with a 1-3 record.

The Buffaloes of Garden City placed first with 38 points, followed by Great Bend High School with 30. Goodland scored 18 points. The

Hays Gold team was fourth and its Maroon team fifth.

The next action for the Cowboys will be the regional tournament Monday in Pratt starting at 8 a.m. (Central Time).



Colby Junior High dominates track meet

Colby Junior High School won all four team competitions at a quadangular track meet hosted Thursday by Grant Junior High.

Grant's seventh-grade boys and girls teams finished third, and both eighth-grade teams finished fourth. Michele Smith was a double-winner for the seventh-grade Lady Mustangs, winning the shot put at 34 feet 5 inches and the discus at 94 feet 5 inches.

Second-place finishers for the seventh-grade girls were Hannah Blake in the 800 and 1,600-meter runs; Erika Gonzales in the 200-meter dash; Whitney Schields in the 100-meter hurdles; and Courtney Sheldon in the pole vault.

Placing third were Shelbi Herl in the 400-meter dash and Danielle Pettibone in the 100-meter dash. Pettibone also placed fourth in the 200-meter dash. Other fourth-place finishers were Kirsten Dutton in the 1,600-meter run, Cassie Cooper in the 800-meter run and Julica Bonsall in the shot put.

Samantha Erickson placed fifth in the discus and Hollie Langley was fifth in the 800-meter run.

The seventh-grade Lady Mustang 4x100, 4x200 and 4x400-meter relay teams all finished third.

For the eighth-grade girls, Sammie Raymer placed second in the 100-meter hurdles and the pole vault. Halli Stone was second in the 3,200-meter run.

Amanda Amthor finished third in the 400-meter run and Ashley Christians was third in the 200-meter dash. Heidi Yonkey was fourth at 200 meters. Cassie Sandoval finished fourth in the discus and fifth in the 1,600-meter run.

Grant's eighth-grade girls' 4x200-meter relay team placed second and their 4x100-meter relay team third.

Andrew Taylor won the seventh-grade boys 100-meter hurdles for the Mustangs in 16.47 seconds.

Fernando Martinez placed second in the 100-meter dash, as did Casey House in the shot put. Travis Angelos finished third in the triple jump.

Fourth-place finishers for Grant were Clay Schilling in the shot put, Brennen Clouse in the triple jump, House in the discus and Martinez in the high jump.

All three of the seventh-grade boys relay teams finished third.

T.J. Hawkins won the eight-grade boys high jump, clearing 5 feet 2

Tanner Smith was third in the pole vault and fourth in the triple jump. Dustin Pennington placed third in the 100-meter hurdles and was fourth in the 3,200-meter run. Toby Hurst was third in the 3,200-meter run and fifth in the 800-meter run.

Grant Wilkens finished fourth in both the 100-meter hurdles and the

shot put. Other fourth-place finishers were Jason Krayca in the shot put and Nick Smith in the discus.

Fifth-place finishers were Jake Kling in the 100-meter dash, Spencer Windell in the 400-meter dash, Josh Doke in the 200-meter dash, Ren Scherling in the discus and Levi Coon in the pole vault.

The eight-grade boys finished second in the 4x200-meter relay and third in both the 4x100 and 4x400-meter relays.

All four teams scheduled for the Northwest Kansas League meet in Hoxie on Thursday.
