Lambrecht led Goodland with a seven-over-par 79. He finished in a three-way tie for fourth place overall, but placed fifth after the tie-breaker.

ished in a three-way tie for eighth, and was placed 10th.

The other medalists for the Cowboys were junior Raymer, who placed 12th with an 82, and freshman Nathan Linin, 18th with an 84.

Junior Brandon Cowan shot a 94 and sophomore Brett Lalicker a 96.

The Tigers of Ulysses High School won the tournament with a team score of 319. The Colby Eagles was second with 321 points. Goodland shot 326.

Youth basketball tourney in Goodland next month

The Goodland High School boys tennis team ended its season at the regional tournament in Pratt on Monday.

Freshman Josh Cech won his first two matches, including a 6-1, 6-2 win over the No. 4 seed Joel Boaldin of Wellington High School. Cech then lost to the No. 5 seed, Austin

Moore of Wichita Collegiate, whose record was 16-7 going into the tournament. Cech finished the season 23-15.

In his first match, sophomore Brandon Zelfer took the No. 2 seed Zach Anderson of Ulysses to three sets before losing 6-1, 4-6 and 6-4. Anderson, who came into the tour-

namment 20-2, went on to win. Zelfer ended his season 19-7.

"Brandon had a tough draw," said Coach Jerry McKee, "but showed real determination trying to overcome his bad luck."

Both of the Cowboys doubles teams lost their first match. Senior Matt Hurst and junior D.J. Sparks
