

# Lady Outlaws split doubleheader with Burlington

 The Lady Outlaws of Goodland split a doubleheader with the Colorado Cougars of Burlington on Wednesday at Centennial Park, winning the first game 15-7 and losing the second 15-12.

In the first match, the Cougars took a 1-0 lead in the top of the first inning, then held the Outlaws to a “three-and-out” in the bottom of the first. Burlington added three more runs in the second and again held Goodland scoreless in the bottom of the inning to take a 4-0 lead into the third.

Things turned around for the Outlaws in the third, as they held the Cougars scoreless. In the bottom of the third, with two outs and nobody on base, Sammie Raymer hit a double to center field, then advanced to third base on a passed ball. Shawnie Butts walked, then Erika Gonzales hit a single to right which scored Raymer and sent Butts to third.

Andrea Wolak drew a walk, loading the bases, then Danielle Pettibone hit a single to the pitcher, who could not handle the ball. That scored Butts and kept the bases loaded, but Burlington got a force out at home with the next batter, ending the inning.

Leading 4-2 going into the top of the fourth, the Cougars added three more runs to increase their lead to 7-2. Then Lady Outlaws had possibly their best turn at bat for the season, sending 17 batters to the plate

and scoring 13 runs, highlighted by a triple by Gonzales that scored two.

With Goodland leading 15-7, the game was called due to a 1 hour, 15 minute-time limit set before the game started.

In the second game, Burlington again took the early lead, scoring three runs in the top of the first, but this time the Outlaws responded with two runs in the bottom of the inning to trail by just one run going into the second.

In the second inning, Goodland outscored the Cougars 7-6 to tie the game at 9 going into the third. Burlington scored six runs during its turn at bat, then held the Outlaws to three runs to take a 15-12 lead. The game again was called due to the time limit, giving the Cougars the win.

The Lady Outlaws are now 2-4 for the season. They will be in Hays today for a three-day tournament which ends Sunday.

## Slice of Life tees off Sunday

The 15th annual “Slice of Life” golf tournament will open with a shotgun start this Sunday at 8:30 at the Sugar Hills Golf Club.

The tournament is part of the “Slice of Life” benefit for the Northwest Kansas Area Medical Foundation and the Goodland Regional Medical Center, which opens with an auction Saturday evening, .

Over a decade and a half, the annual benefit has raised almost \$250,000 for the center. Some of the money is used for scholarships for area students studying for a career in health care who agree to return and work for the center.

The tournament format consists of three-player teams, men, women or mixed. The teams will be divided into four flights, with the top three teams in each flight receiving prizes. Par for the course is 71 for 18 holes, 35 on the front nine and 36 on the back.

Three holes will offer a special prize for a hole-in-one. Players will have the chance to win a 2004 Harley Davidson motorcycle, an automobile or \$10,000 in cash split between the player and the foundation.

The benefit social and auction will start at 6 p.m. Saturday at the Veterans of Foreign Wars Hall, 824

Main Ave. Guests can enjoy hors d’oeuvres and beverages while they mingle with entertainment, political and sports celebrities. Items up for auction include trips, hotel stays, recreation items and autographed movie posters and pictures. Sports memorabilia autographed by celebrities from the NFL, NBA, NHL, NASCAR and NCAA will be up for bid. Admission to the auction and social for those not playing in the golf tournament is \$30 per person.

This year’s honorary chairman is former Kansas Jayhawk basketball player Issac “Bud” Stallworth. He was the first-round draft choice for the Seattle SuperSonics in 1972 and later played for the New Orleans Jazz.

Former Jayhawk Jo Jo White also will be there. White was a first-round draft choice of the Boston Celtics in 1969 and played 10 seasons with the team. Other former NBA players participating are former San Antonio Spurs player George “Iceman” Gervin and former Denver Nuggets Walter Davis and “Fatty” Taylor.

Former Denver Broncos taking part this year include last year’s honorary chairman, Billy Thompson, Larry Brunson, Jack Gehrke, John Grant, Fran Lynch, Wade

Manning, Leroy Mitchell, Dave Studdard and Willie Oshodin.

Former members of the Kansas City Chiefs include 2003’s honorary chairman Walter White, Jerry Corneilson, Larry Marchall, Ted McKnight, Tony Reed, Dave Lindstrom and Billy Masters.

Olympic gold medalist, and Vietnam veteran, Mel Pender also will be on hand. Pender earned a gold medal as part of the 4x100-meter relay team in the 1968 Olympic Games in Mexico City.

Other celebrities attending include Larry “Gator” Rivers, Bucky Schribner, Charley Johnson, Cliff Meely and Bobby Douglass. Douglass, a native of El Dorado, played quarterback for the University of Kansas, taking the team to the Orange Bowl in 1968, and went on to the Chicago Bears.
