## Bible says life is God's gift, death is the Devil's will

A woman called me and wrote a letter expressing concerns about what I wrote in my most recent column concerning the death of Sen. Stan Clark.

Death is not a certainty for everyone. Neither is eternity. Matthew 25:46 says, "And these will depart in general, and he has the means to into everlasting cutting-off, but the righteous ones into everlasting life."

2 Peter 2 mentions false prophets and other wicked ones and then says in the second part of verse 3, "But as for them, the judgment from of old is not moving slowly, and the destruction of them is not slumbering."

The wicked will be destroyed, forever. The Bible is clear that eter-
