The Carnegie Arts Center display for June showcases nature photographs taken throughout Colorado.

The display, “A Walk in the Wilderness,” by Dave Showalter of Arvada, Colo., contains scenes of mountains, waterfall, flowers and animals. Showalter, who has been photographing nature for 14 years, says he still experiences a sense of wonder of the great outdoors.

“I hope my work conveys that sense of wonder and my belief that wild places and wild creatures must be protected,” he said, “not only for future generations, but because at a soul level, we humans want to know that some places are still wild and free.”

Showalter and his wife Marla, both avid outdoorsmen, have traveled throughout Colorado, the western United States, Alaska, Nepal and New Zealand.

“Around the time Marla and I were getting serious about backpacking and a backcountry lifestyle,” he said, “I saw a display of Ansel Adams prints and realized we were witnessing great events in



nature on a regular basis. I decided to try photography, and my passion grew from there.”

Showalter uses 35mm color slide film. His work has been displayed at Recreation Equipment Inc. and the Slideprinter in Denver and at the Arvada YMCA, where he teaches. His work will be in Goodland through Wednesday, June 30.
