Lady Outlaws sweep doubleheader

The Lady Outlaws won both games of their doubleheader against Sharon Springs Wednesday afternoon at Centennial Park winning the first game 16-4 and the second 18-3.

In the first game, Sharon Springs took a 1-0 lead in the top of the first inning however, Goodland responded with six runs in the bottom

of the inning.

The Outlaws' defense faced a total of seven batters in the second and third innings while not allowing Sharon Springs to score. Offensively, Goodland scored two runs in the bottom of the second and added five more in the third.

Sharon Springs scored a pair of runs in the top of the fourth after

which the Outlaws scored three in the bottom of the inning to make the score 16-3. Sharon Springs added one more run in the fifth inning. With Goodland leading 16-4 the game was called due to the "10-after-five" rule.

The Outlaws continued to dominate their opponents in the second game holding Sharon Springs

scoreless for the first two innings while scoring 12 runs in the first inning. Goodland was held to a "three-and-out" series in the second.

Sharon Springs got on the scoreboard with a pair of runs in the top of the third and the Outlaws scored a pair of their own in the bottom of the inning to make the score 14-2

going into the fourth. Then Sharon Springs picked up another run but Goodland responded with four more runs to make it 18-3 when the game was called.

The Lady Outlaws are now 6-13 for the season. Last weekend's tournament in Russell was canceled due to wet field conditions. Their next action is this weekend at the Colby

Girls Fastpitch Association Invitational tournament starting at 9 a.m. (Central Time) against Hays at the softball complex on the north side of Colby. Goodland will play three pool games on Saturday then compete in a single-elimination round on Sunday.
