Swim team wins 47 events, 11 trophies this season

The Goodland swim team won 40 individual events and seven relays to earn four fourth-place finishes and one fifth-place finish for the season.

The 43-member team kicked off the season Saturday, June 5, with a fifth-place finish at Holyoke. They had five individual and one relay gold medals.

Daniel Blake won two of the individual medals, and his sister Hannah Blake, Riley

The team had seven individual gold medals and finished fourth in the June 12 meet in Burlington. D. Blake earned gold in three events, H. Blake won two gold medals, and O'Harah and Clouse each earned one.

At the June 19 meet in Oakley, the team braved cold and rainy weather to earn another fourth-place finish. H. Blake, D. Blake and Clouse each won two gold medals, and Holton Witman and O'Harah each won one.

Goodland's 8-and-under boys 100-yard freestyle relay team of Miller, Colton Cooper, Drew House and Witman brought home the gold, as did the 9-10 mixed 100yard freestyle team of O'Harah, Kassarah Woodrow, Chloe Goodwin and Shayley Miller.

The Goodland team finished one point behind Wray, Colo., for the fourth-place finish June 26 in Colby. The team earned 10 individual gold medals and two golds for relays. Four Goodland swimmers, O'Harah, H. Blake, Clouse and D. Blake, each won two medals. Witman and Kerek Mason each won one.

Goodland won the 8-and-under boys 100-yard freestyle relay with the team of Z. Miller, Cooper, House and Witman. The team of Chelsey Horney, Bryan Gray, Halli Stone and Clouse won the 13-14 mixed 200-yard relay.

Swim League Championship Meet in Wray, Colo.

Goodland swimmers brought home gold medals in 10 individual events and two relays.

Two swimmers from Goodland tied for the League Championship Trophy, which is awarded to the boy and girl in each age group who earns the most points during the two-day meet. Nine swimmers earned trophies for being one of the top six point-earners in their group during the season.

D. Blake won four events in the boys 15-18 competition. The 33 points he earned at the meet placed him in a tie for the League Championship Trophy, and he was the top point-earner in his age group this season with 106.

O'Harah won two events in the 9-10 boys competition. His 29 points during the weekend earned him a tie for the League Championship Trophy, and he was the second Jolly.
