The Lady Outlaws softball team had their best tournament of the season this weekend, going 2-2 at the Colby Girls Fastpitch Association Invitational.

Coach Grady Bonsall said the girls played well and did a great job at the plate, suffering only six strike outs in four games.

In Goodland's opening game Saturday, the Outlaws faced an inspired Hays team that jumped out to a 9-0 lead in the first inning. The Strikers added two runs in the second and one in the third while keeping Goodland scoreless to win 12-0. The game was called due to a 1 hour, 15 minute time limit.
