The Goodland Star-News Coach Tony Diehl started the Cowboys on their drive back to the state football playoffs shortly after midnight Monday morning.

This is Diehl's third season leading the high school's football program. In the 2002 season, his first as head coach, the Cowboys went 5-5, after finishing 0-9 the year before, and qualified for the state playoffs. In 2003, Goodland was 8-3 defeating Kingman 35-0 in the first round of the playoffs before losing to Wellington in the second 40-20.

Diehl said 59 players turned out for football this year, the highest total in his three years as a Cowboy coach. He said he and his staff are working on a new philosophy for the team this year which will incorporate a more balanced offense.

Diehl, a 1992 graduate of Mid-America Nazarene University in Olathe, started teaching high school English in the 2001-2002 school year. That season, he was an assistant football coach for the eighthgrade Mustangs of Grant Junior High, who finished 4-3.

For his freshman and sophomore years Diehl, a defensive end, played football for the Lions of Missouri Southern State College in Joplin. He then transferred to MidAmerica Nazarene, where he was a National Association for Intercollegiate Athletics All-American his senior year and twice an all-conference selection.

Diehl will be the Cowboy's defensive coordinator this season as well as working with the offensive line and linebackers. He also oversees the team's conditioning and weight training program.

Helping Diehl again this season is Jon McLean, who will be the offensive coordinator and will work with the defensive backs. McLean, who teaches world geography and freshman physical education, is in his sixth year on the football staff.

McLean played four seasons of eight-man football, as a running and defensive back, with Lewis High School and three years on the Bethany College football team as a running back. Initially, he went to Bethany on a basketball scholarship where he played four seasons for the
