## University honor four area teachers

Four area teachers are among 1,079 Kansas public school teachers who received certificates from Angela Lumpkin, dean of education at the University of Kansas, 25 years or more service to Kansas schools.

Brenda S. Hagerman of Goodland, Vigil Fischer and Bruce Bolen of Sharon Springs and Jeffery E. Olofson of St. Francis all received 25 year awards. Hagerman teaches science at Grant Junior High, Fischer teaches industrial arts and

welding at Wallace Community High School, Bolen is an administrator, and Olofson teaches science at St. Francis High School.

This year's honored teachers represent 185 of the 302 unified school districts in Kansas and three interlocal districts in 91 of the state's 105 counties.

"We are thrilled to honor the service and expertise of these dedicated teachers," Lumpkin said. "Every day for more than two decades, they have been the profes-

sionals who have mentored and shaped the lives of thousands of students."

Of the 1,079 teachers recognized by KU this year, 822 have been teaching for 25 years, 244 have been teaching between 25 and 35 years, and 13 have more than 35 years of service.

KU's School of Education asks Kansas school districts to name teachers who should receive certificates. Some districts do not participate.
