'Drive for Sobriety' tees off on Sept. 11 at Sugar Hills

The Thomas County Alcohol and Drug Abuse Council is sponsoring its fourth annual "Drive for Sobriety" golf tournament Saturday, Sept. 11, at the Sugar Hills golf course.

Pat Willoughby, fund-raising chairperson for the council, said 14 teams participated in the tournament last year, raising more than \$5,000. She said the tournament has raised almost \$20,000 in its first three years.

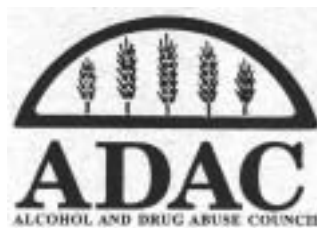
Willoughby said the money stays in northwest Kansas, supporting services the council provides for people of the region.

The tournament will be a four-player scramble, she said. Tee time is 9 a.m. All four members of each team will tee off, then all four will all take their next shot from the best lie among them. Prizes will be awarded to the top three teams in each flight.

The registration fee — \$60 per player, \$240 per team — includes a golf cart and lunch. On-site registration begins at 8 a.m. Teams can register early by mailing entry forms to the council at Box 100, Colby, Kan. 67701. The fee does not have to accompany the form; it can

be paid at tee time. Forms are available at Sugar Hills or by calling the council at (785) 462-6111.

The prize for this year's Hole-In-One Contest is a 2004 Easy-Go golf cart. The hole for the contest is No. 10, one of four par-three holes on the par-71 course. Other prizes will be awarded throughout the day.

Willoughby said this tournament is always held in September, during National Alcohol and Drug Abuse Recovery Month, as part of the council's effort to "make people aware treatment works and recovery is possible."

The council helps people and their families having problems with alcohol and/or other drugs, she said. The clinical staff are all state certified and have degrees in health services. The main office is at 1523 W. Fourth St., Colby, and the agency has office hours twice a week at the Sherman County courthouse in Goodland.
