Broncbusters open season Saturday

Goodland's Don Raymer, a sophomore wide receiver for Garden City Community College, will start his second season with the Broncbusters on Saturday when they play Dodge City Community College at home.

The game kicks off at 7 p.m. on the new turf at Garden City Memorial Stadium. Last season, Garden City defeated the Conquistadors 21-19 in the season opener.

Last year, the Broncbusters were 5-5 overall and 4-3 in the Kansas

Jayhawk Community College Conference. They were picked No. 3 in the conference coaches' preseason poll. Dodge City was picked fifth.

Raymer played in all 10 games for Garden City last year. As a wide receiver, he caught four passes for 58 yards and on special teams he returned one kickoff for seven yards.

Tomi, the daughter of Mike and Kelly Windell of Kanorado, graduated from Goodland High School in May. In addition to volleyball, she lettered in softball for the Cowgirls and was active in the Family Career Community Leaders of America.

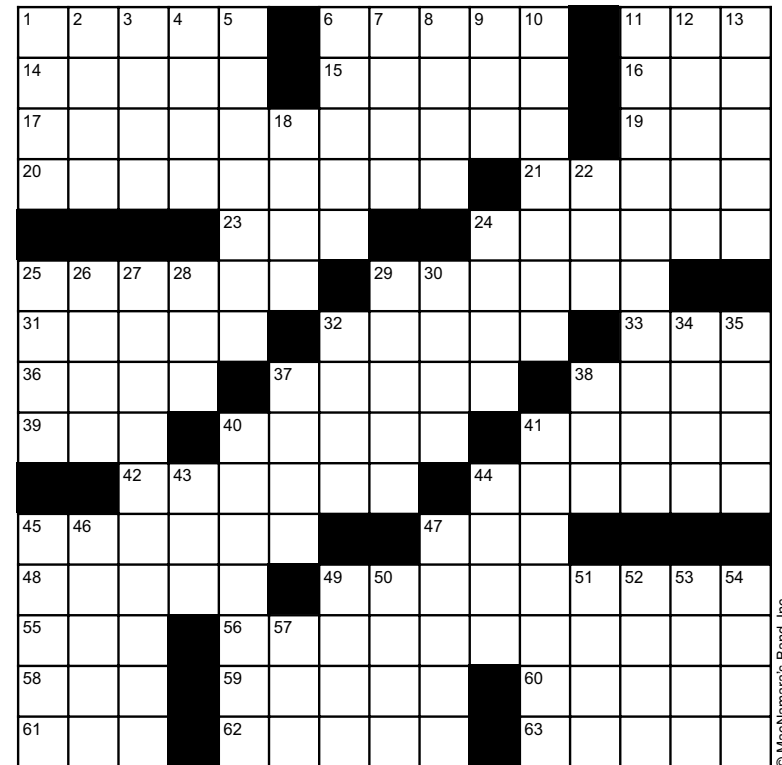
