### College football in Goodland

## Girls tennis places fifth at Colby

The Goodland High School tennis girls finished fifth out of eight teams at the Colby Varsity Invitational on Saturday.

"We competed much better than we did at Phillipsburg," said coach Wallace Hansen. "It was a long, but good day of tennis for the team."

Leading the way for the Cowgirls were juniors Kali Rietcheck and Megan Stefan, who placed third at No. 2 doubles by finishing 3-2 for the tournament. The pair went 2-1 in pool play, lost to Phillipsburg 8-5 in their cross-bracket match, then

defeated Colby's A team 8-4 for third place.

Goodland's No. 1 doubles team, senior Grace Langness and sophomore Jena McCall, finished fifth with a 3-2 record. After going 1-2 in pool play, the pair defeated Ulysses 8-0 in their cross-bracket match, then defeated Osborne 8-3 for fifth place.

Sophomore Jessica Parker, playing at No. 1 singles, went 2-3 and finished sixth. She went 1-2 in pool play then defeated Kyndall Ewing of Ulysses 8-0 in a cross-bracket

match. Parker then lost a tough match requiring a tie-breaker to Norton's Jessie Duscher 9-8 (7-2). Hansen said the match featured several outstanding volleys.

Sophomore Jessica Lu, playing in her first varsity singles competition, was seventh at No. 2 singles with a 2-3 record. She went 1-2 in pool play then lost to Norton's Samantha Brasted 9-7 in their cross-bracket match. Lu defeated Krista Torres of Ulysses 8-1 for seventh place.
