# Cowboys corral Buffaloes, 50-6

Two Indian attacks and a Buffalo herd have not hindered the Cowboys, as they continue along the trail back to the state playoffs.

Goodland defeated Rawlins County High School 50-6 Friday night in Atwood to keep the Cowboys unbeaten for the season. In the first half, the Goodland offense could not be stopped and the defense shut down the Buffaloes' attack.

"I was happy with our defense," said coach Jon McLean. "We had a good pass and good coverage. Our special teams played really well, giving us tremendous field position throughout the game."

The Cowboys surged out to a 21-0 lead in the first quarter on three touchdowns by senior fullback Brock Lohr, all on short runs. In the second quarter, Goodland score three more touchdowns.

The first was on a 5-yard pass play from senior quarterback Derrick Raymer to junior wide receiver Heath Chatfield about three min-

utes into the period.

Six minutes later, with the Buffaloes on their own 1, senior nose guard Anthony Benavides tackled the quarterback in the end zone for a safety.

The second Cowboy touchdown of the quarter came about 45 seconds later on a two-yard run by senior tailback Lane Winter. The third came with 20 seconds left in the half on a 2-yard keeper by Raymer. Goodland led 43-0 at the half.

Because of the Cowboy's lead, officials implemented a continuous clock for the second half. During that time the game clock only stops during an officials' or team's time out, end of a quarter or for an injury.

For the second half, coach McLean started giving his back-up players some time. The two teams held each other scoreless for most of the third quarter until, with about 2 1/2 minutes left, Buffaloes' running back Jeff Reisner ran around the left end for a 33-yard touchdown. The two-point conversion attempt failed and the score was 43-6.

In the fourth quarter, the Cow-

boys got in the end zone one more time when freshman Casey Henderson ran 53-yards down the left sideline for touchdown with a little under 10 minutes left in the game.

Both teams were scoreless for the rest of the game.

The Cowboys improved to 3-0

for the season while Rawlins County dropped to 0-3.

Goodland gained 386 yards on offense, including 323 on the ground, while holding the Buffaloes to 101 yards. Both teams fumbled four times, losing three. Atwood was intercepted once.

Lohr led the Cowboy rushing attack for the second straight week, gaining 90 yards on 18 carries. He scored three touchdowns, two on runs of eight yards and one of three. Henderson rushed four times for 63 yards, most of them on his touchdown run, and senior David Livengood ran six times for 61 yards. Winter gained 52 yards on six carries.

Raymer completed five of eight passes for 63 yards, including his touchdown to Chatfield. He ran eight times for 38 yards. As place-kicker, Raymer made five of six extra point attempts.

Senior Bret Jarmin caught two of Raymer's passes for 51 yards. Livengood caught two for seven yards.

Junior Bobby Miller played quarterback for the Cowboys in the second half. He ran for 18 yards on two carries.

Jarmin had the game's only interception, in the second quarter, which he returned 12 yards to the Buffaloes 20.

McLean said both the offensive

and defensive lines have done a good job this season, and that is where the game is controlled. He said he is pleased with the performance of senior linemen Dexter Deeds, Blake Saint, Brandon Cowan and Bret Jarmin, along with junior Mark Starr and sophomore John Mosbarger. He said Benavides is doing an exceptional job as nose guard.

McLean said everybody who suited up Friday got some playing time. He said it always good for the team when the younger players get some experience.

Next up for the Cowboys is their homecoming game against Decatur Community High of Oberlin. The Red Devils are 1-2 for the season after losing to Colby 36-28 Friday. Game time is 6 p.m. at Cowboy Stadium.
