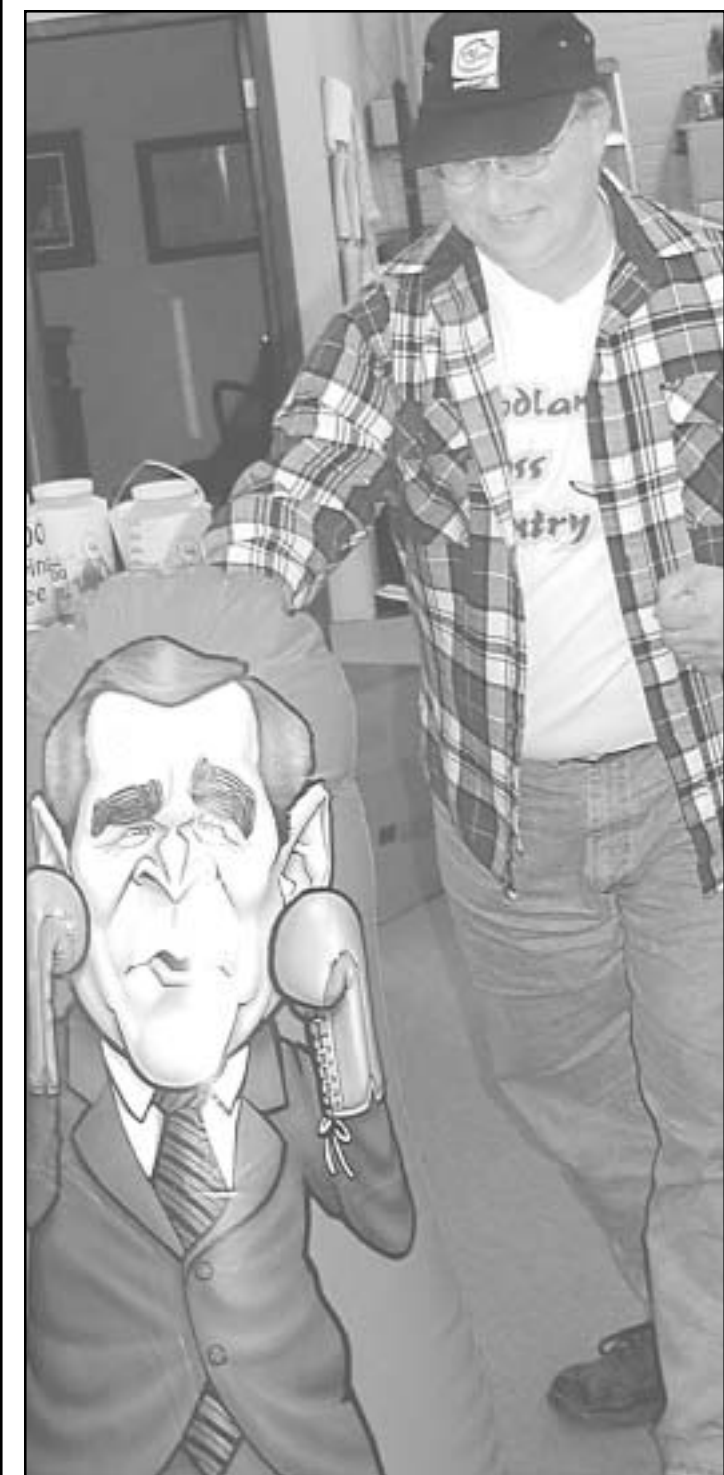


Punch a candidate
