## Brewster wins League volleyball tourney

The Lady Bulldogs of Brewster High School won all five of their matches Tuesday at the Western Kansas Liberty League volleyball tournament, improving their record to 41-5.

Brewster won its first match in pool play 25-11, 25-18 against Golden Plains High School of Rexford. In their second match, the Bulldogs defeated Triplains High of Winona 25-16, 25-21, then beat Grinnell 25-5, 25-18 to advance to

the championship bracket.

In their semi-final match, the Bulldogs beat the Lady Shockers of Wheatland High School of Grainfield 25-16, 25-20 sending Brewster into the title match against Greeley County High of Tribune. The Jackrabbits, who went 3-1 in pool play, defeated Golden Plains 25-22, 25-21 in the other semi-final.

In the championship match, Greeley County won the first game 27-25, but the Bulldogs dominated

the second 25-14. In the third game, the teams played close with Brewster edging the Jackrabbits 15-13 to win the tournament.

Wheatland defeated Golden Plains 25-20, 19-25, and 15-12 in the consolation match for third place.

The Bulldogs are seeded No. 3 at the state Class 1A tournament, which starts with pool play today at Busch-Gross Coliseum on the campus of Fort Hays State University.

The championship bracket will be played Saturday.

Brewster will face No. 6 seed Tipton, 27-6 for the season, in its first match scheduled for 4:30 (Central Time) this afternoon. About two hours later, the Bulldogs will play the No. 7-seeded Lady Leopards of La Crosse, followed by a match against Flinthills High School of Rosalia, the No. 2 seed.

Saturday's schedule will depend on the results Friday.

## Goodland runner takes fourth

Former Cowboy Espiririon "Speedy" Aguilar placed fourth at the National Junior College Athletic Association Region VI cross country meet Monday in El Dorado.

Aguilar, a freshman at Hutchinson Community College, finished the 8,000-meter course, about 4.9-miles, in 26 minutes 56.11 seconds. Teammate Michael Hemphil, also a freshman, finished 10th in 27 minutes 34.2 seconds. Seventy-four runners completed the race.

Aguilar is a 2004 graduate of Goodland High School who lettered in cross country and track for the Cowboys, and a member of Family Career Community Leaders of America. He is the son of Louis and

The two helped the Blue Dragons finish third in the team competition among the 10 teams there. Hutchinson's first five finishers all placed in the top 25.

Jake Raines of Barton County Community College in Great Bend won the men's race in 25 minutes 23.57 seconds. Johnson County Community College won the team title with Butler County Community College, the host, taking second.
