Goodland man displays wood work

A Goodland wood turner has his work on display at the Carnegie Arts Center this month, and will explain the process of turning a piece of wood into a work of art Saturday in the gallery.

George Adelgren, a retired carpenter, will give a gallery talk at 1:30 p.m. Saturday. Besides explaining how he turns wood into art, Adelgren will display some of the smaller tools he uses and demonstrate the art of pyrography, or wood burning.

Adelgren said he began creating art with wood about five years ago. "I've always enjoyed art of all kinds," he said. "I just didn't get the chance to do any until retirement."

Adelgren said he enjoys finding what nature has hidden in tree roots, knots and burrs. He combines wood turning, carving and pyrography to create unique pieces. He also works with elk and moose antlers, seed

pod, nuts and plastics in combination with exotic and local woods.

The unique shapes and designs of his work were influenced by Dale Scott, a wood turner in Colorado Springs. Scott is known for his wood turnings across the United States and has been featured in wood turning magazines.

Adelgren said he attended a week-long class taught by Allan Batty from England, one of the top wood turners in the world.

Adelgren graduated from Chanute Junior College and served two years in the Army. Most recently, he taught carpentry at the Northwest Kansas Technical College. He and his wife Gorda have two daughters and a son.

Adelgren's gallery show is sponsored by State Farm Insurance and Hitchcock Inc. There is no charge for the show or for his talk.
